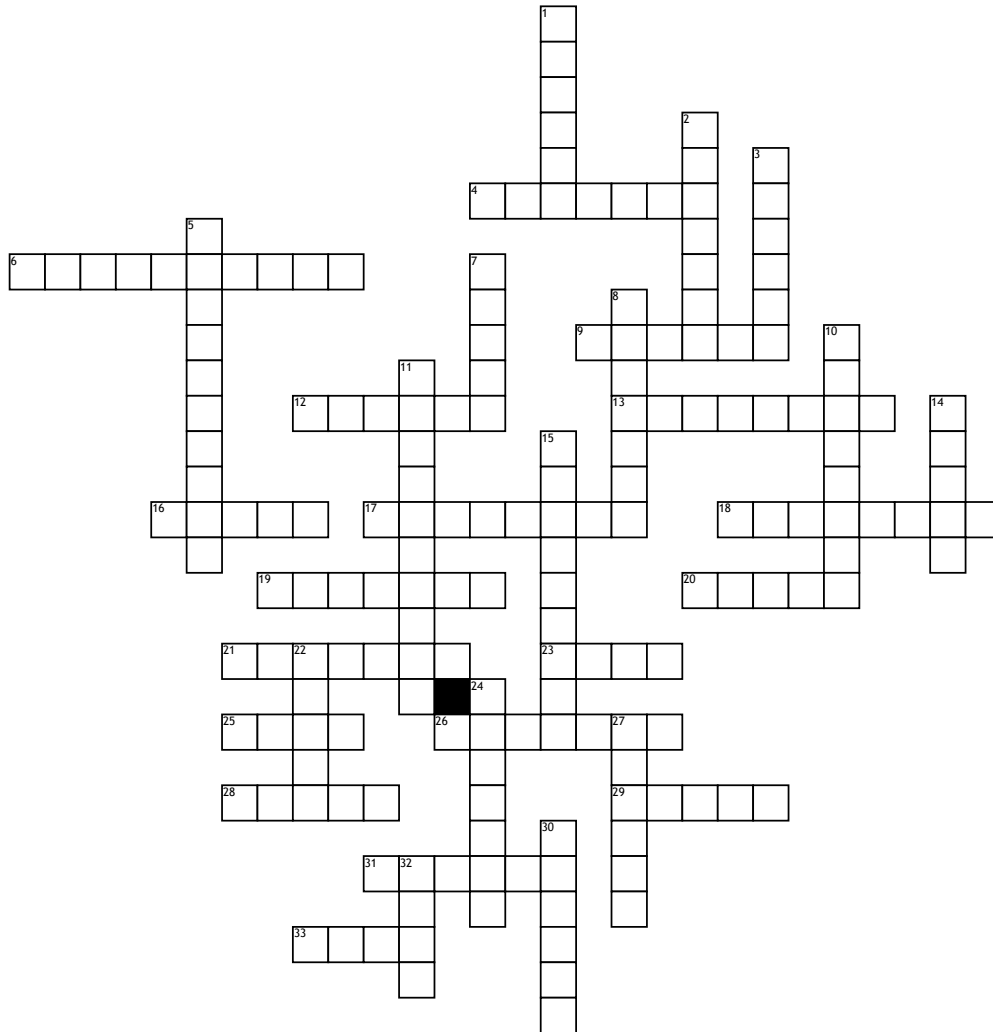

- 4. beautiful woman created to punish men; responsible for evils in the world
 - 6. kidnapped by Hades and taken to the underworld; Demeter's (her mother) grief caused the earth to become unfruitful (seasons)
 - 9. father time; maimed Uranus with a sickle; swallowed children
 - 12. Son of Daedalus who was killed while flying from the labyrinth because he disregarded his father's advice and flew too close to the sun
 - 13. Zeus' son; performed 12 labors to cleanse his sins (killing his wife and children); known for his strength
 - 16. nine goddesses of the arts
 - 17. three-headed dog that guards the underworld
 - 18. one-eyed monsters; gives Zeus thunderbolt
 - 19. challenged Athena to a weaving contest; turned into a spider
 - 20. known for his "golden touch"
 - 21. half man, half horse
 - 23. the river of death that souls must travel across to reach the underworld
 - 25. mother earth
 - 26. hero who was responsible for slaying Medusa
 - 28. Hero who led the Argonauts in search of the Golden Fleece
 - 29. Titan who is forced to hold the earth on his shoulders
 - 31. Titaness with a head of snakes who could turn men into stone with a glance
 - 33. talkative nymph punished by Hera; fell in love with Narcissus

- 1. ferries the souls of the dead across the River Styx to the shores
 - 2. tried to drive Apollo's sun chariot but lost control of the horses thereby causing solar disturbances and many of the earth's features
 - 3. goddesses and gods of nature (seas, mountains, trees, etc.)
 - 5. Titan; responsible for giving creatures differences (after thinker); given Pandora as a wife
 - 7. Black void; confusion
 - 8. The great musician who journeyed into the underworld to bring back his wife
 - 10. builder of the labyrinth who escaped from it by making wings of wax and flying out
 - 11. Titan; fore-thinker; gave man fire; often given credit for creating humans from dirt; chained to a mountain for giving man fire
 - 14. Clotho, Atropos, Lachesis; responsible for spinning the thread of life, drawing the thread out and cutting the thread
 - 15. handsome youth who fell in love with his reflection; turned into a flower
 - 22. water nymphs
 - 24. winged horse
 - 27. father sky
 - 30. goat-men found in nature
 - 32. god of love, son of Aphrodite
