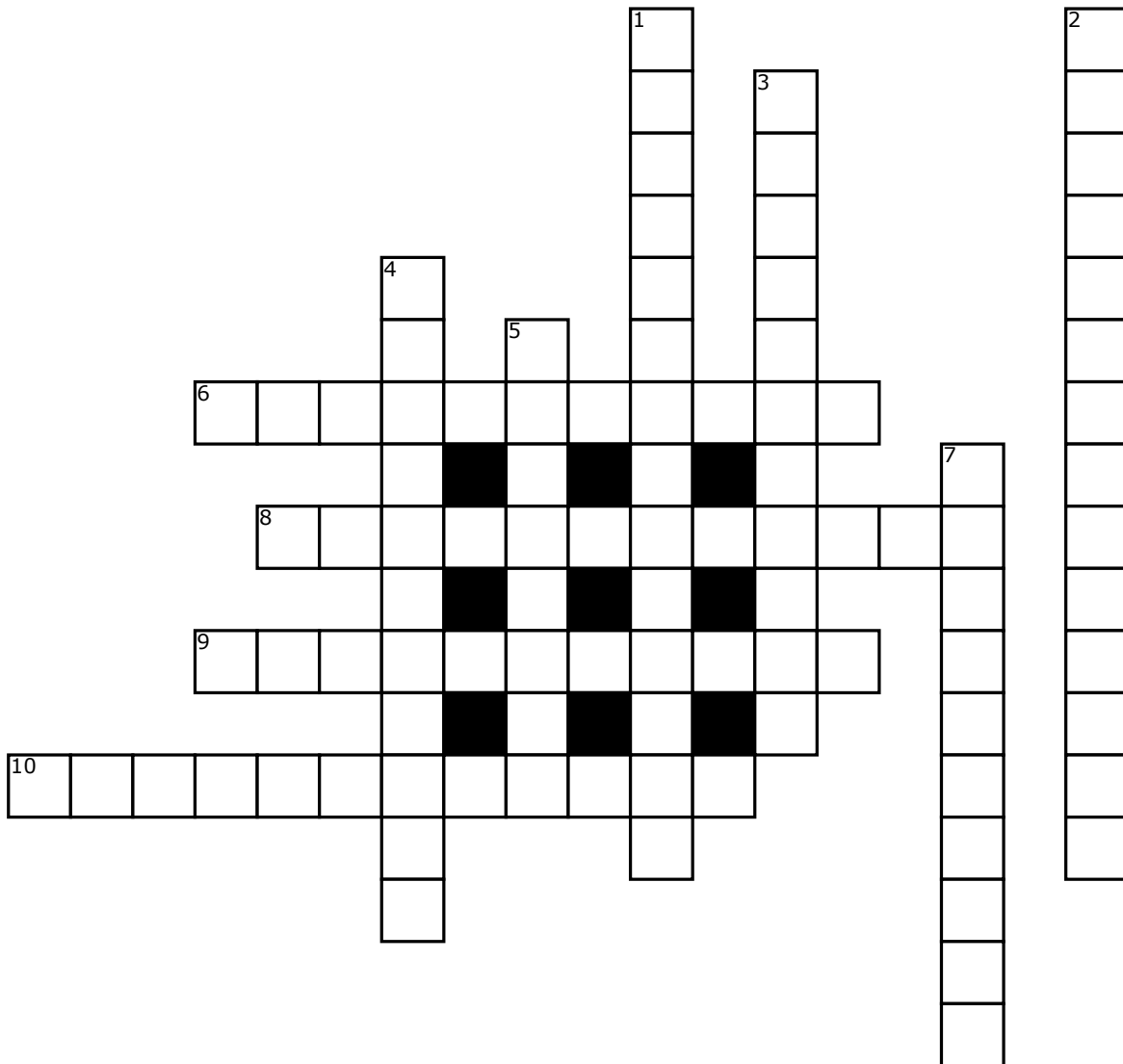


Greek and Latin Roots: "STRUCT"
