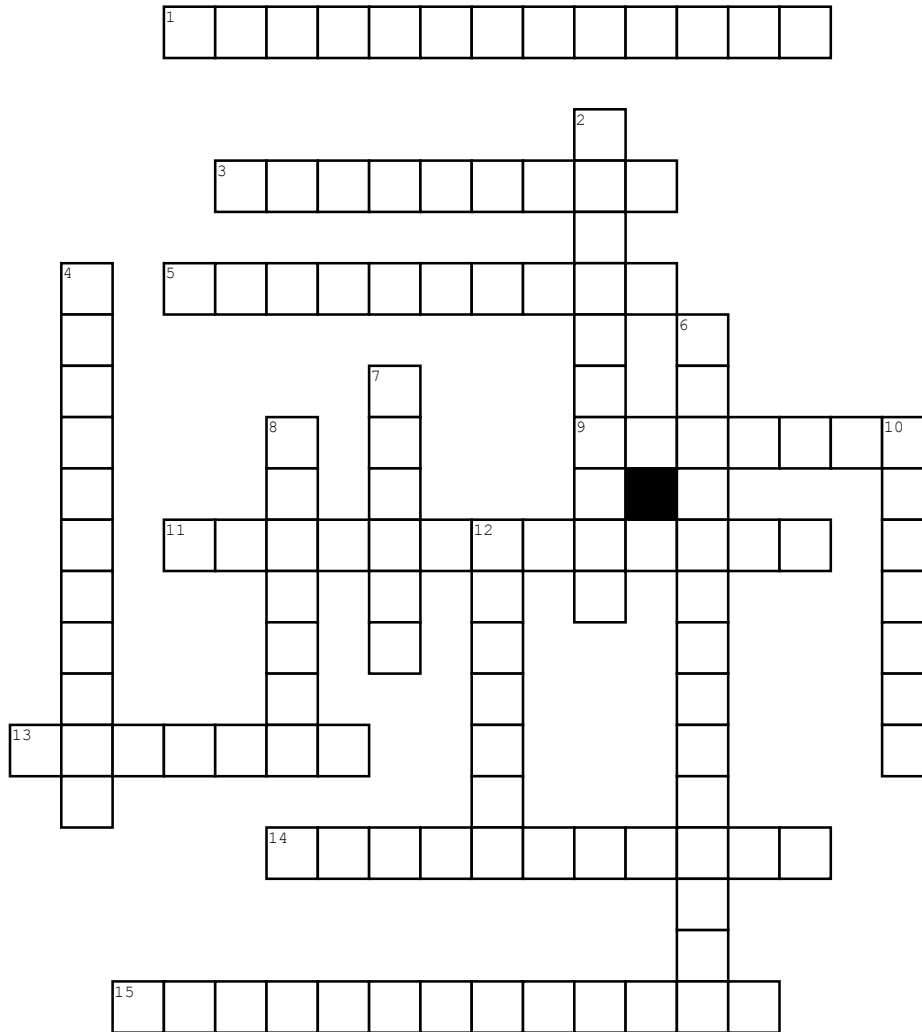


Greenhouse Gasses
