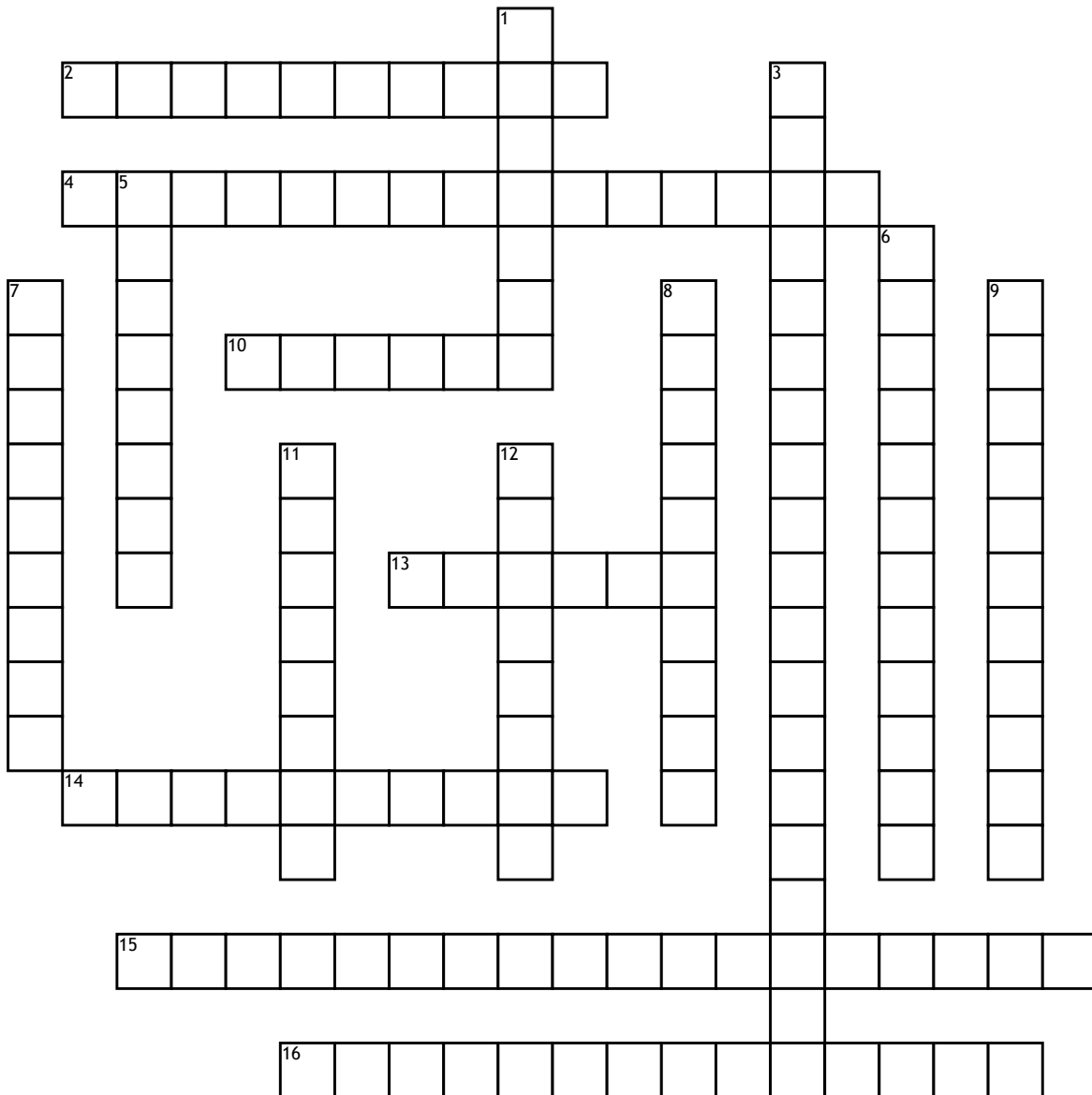


Gross Pay



Across

- 2. An amount of money paid to an employee for selling a product or service.
- 4. The total amount of money earned for a pay period at the hourly rate.
- 10. A fixed amount of money earned on a regular basis, received weekly, biweekly, semimonthly, or monthly.
- 13. Paid every week or 52 times per year.
- 14. An overtime pay rate of two times more than the regular hourly rate, often paid for working Sundays and holidays.

15. Pay that consists only of money earned on commission.

16. A specified amount of money paid to an employee for each sale made or a percent of the total value of sales made.

Down

- 1. Paid once a month or 12 times per year.
- 3. Pay in which the commission rate is different for different levels of sales.
- 5. A record of the time you report for work and the time you depart each day of the week.

6. An overtime pay rate of 1½ times more than the regular hourly rate.

7. A specified amount of money paid to an employee for each item of work completed.

8. A fixed amount of money paid for each hour of work.

9. Paid twice a month or 24 times per year.

11. Paid every other week or 26 times per year.

12. Extra pay for hours worked beyond regular hours.
