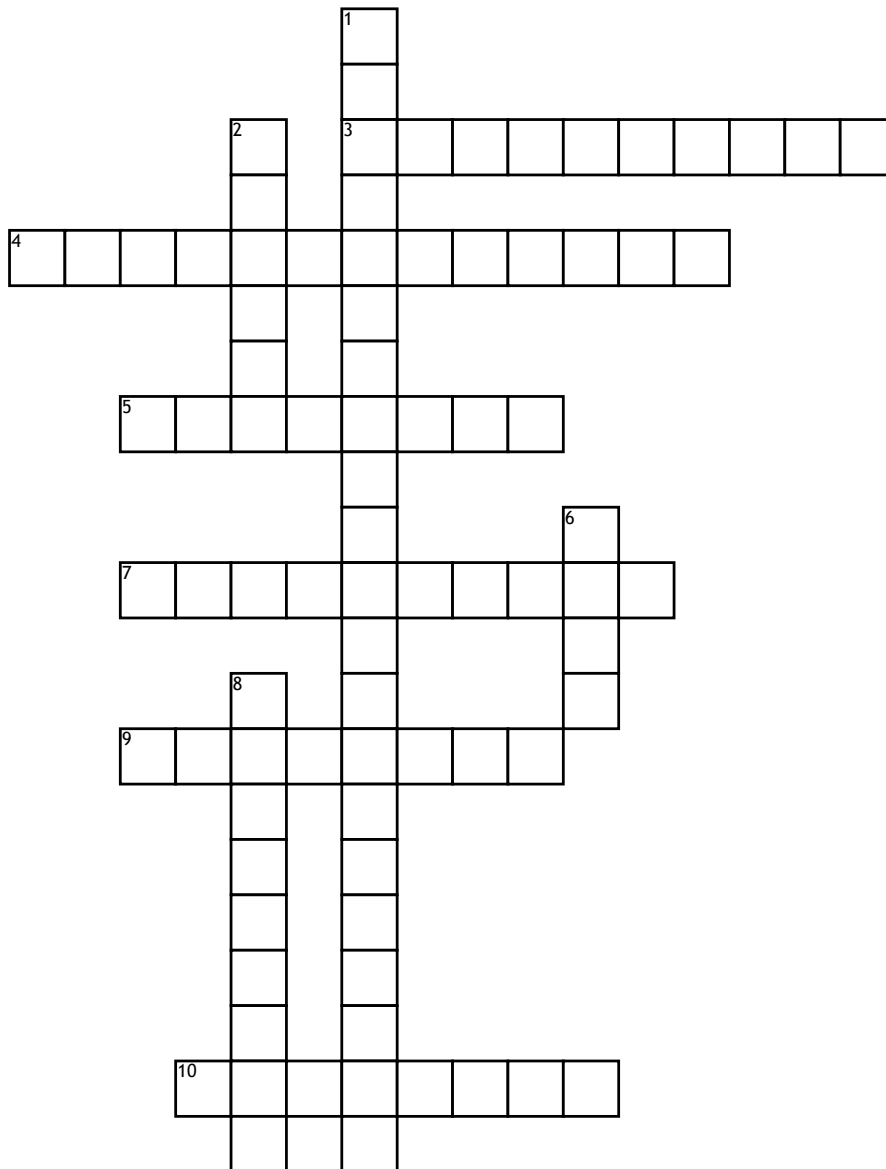

1. This theory of motivation contends that individuals engage in tasks that have value to them so long as the cost is low
