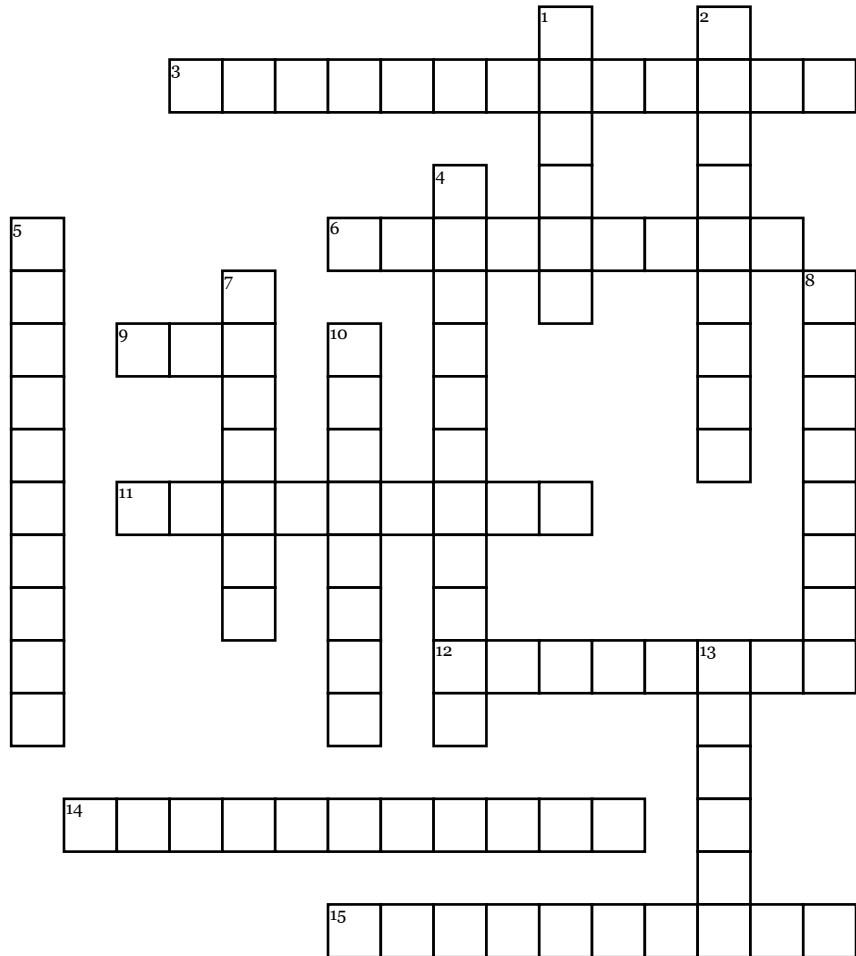
15. is the largest denomination of Islam, followed by 87–90% of the world's Muslims.
