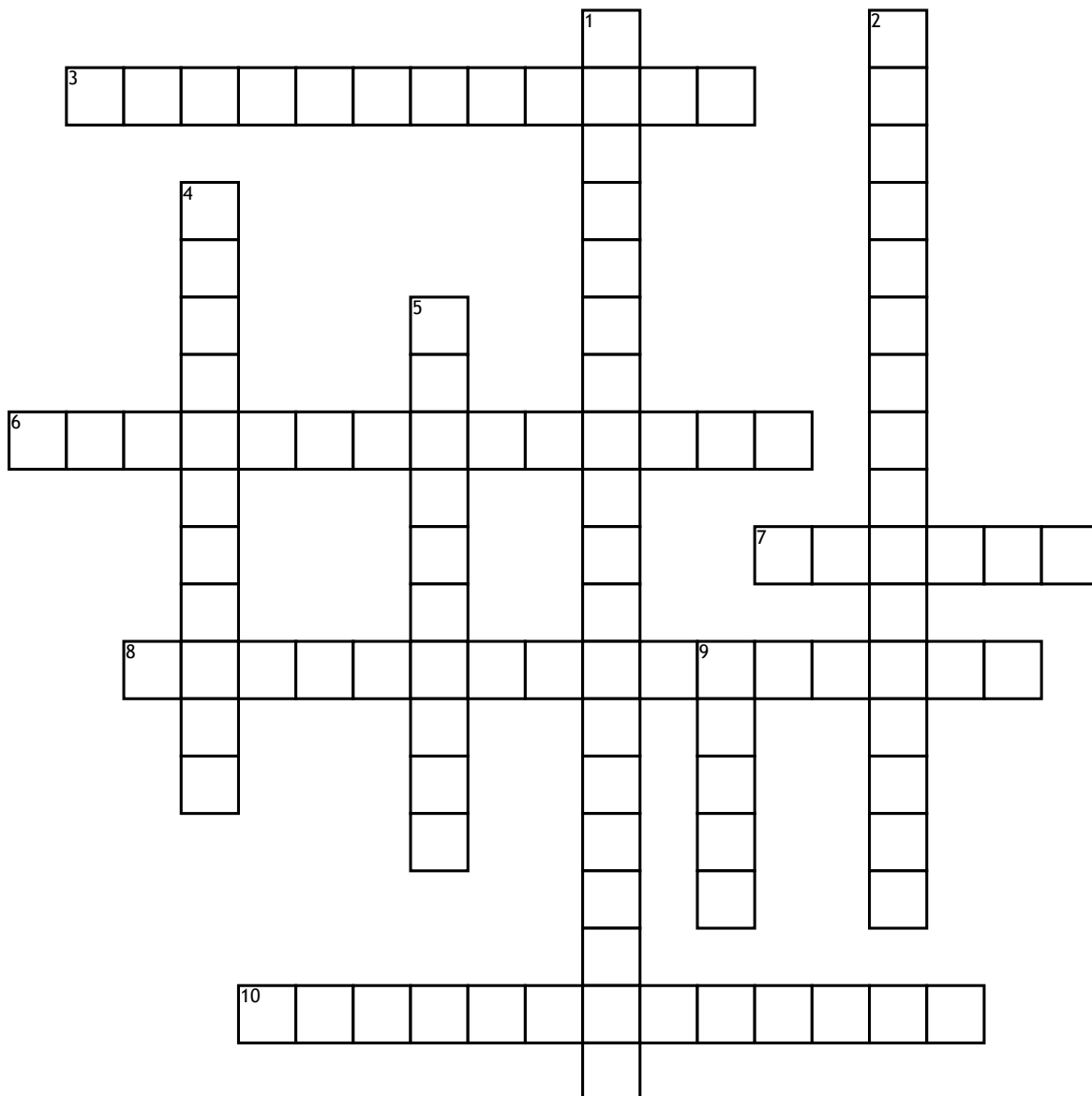

3. ducts which ends in the sublingual caruncles
6. route to the mouth of saliva from the sublingual glands
7. clear fluid secreted by the salivary and mucous glands through the mouth
8. route to the sublingual caruncles of the saliva from the sublingual glands
10. largest of the salivary glands which lies just below and in front of the ear

Down

1. these glands are about the size of a walnut and lie on the inside of the mandible in the posterior area
2. smallest of the salivary glands located on the floor of the mouth
4. also known as Stensen's duct this duct empties into the mouth through the parotid papilla
5. excess dryness of the mouth
9. how many major pairs of salivary glands secrete saliva into the oral cavity assisting in the process of digestion
