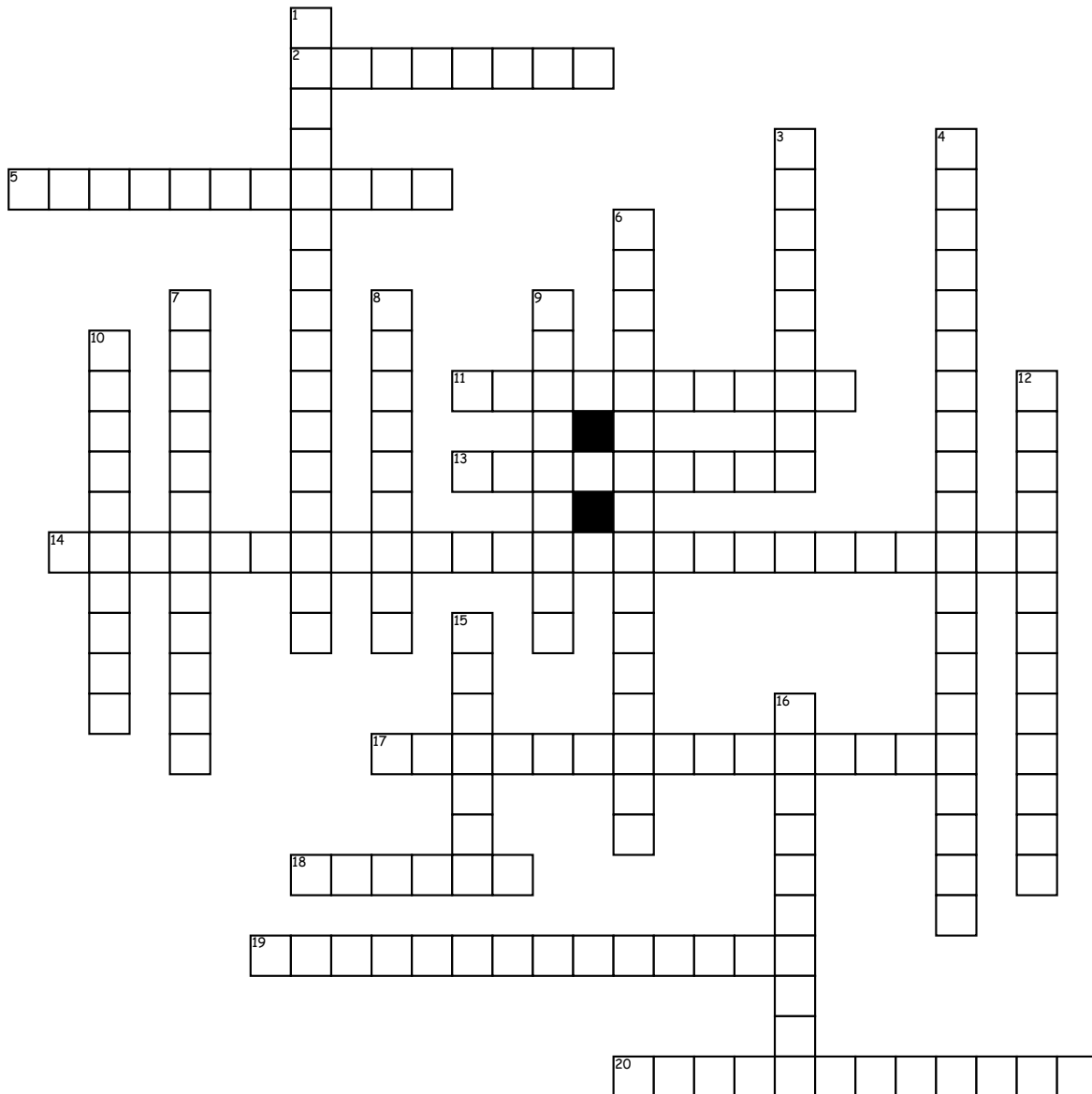

- 13. a solvent or other material producing vapor inhaled by drug abusers.

- 17. a synthetic steroid hormone that resembles testosterone in promoting the growth of muscle. Such hormones are used medicinally to treat some forms of weight loss and (illegally) by some athletes and others to enhance physical performance.

- 3. a chronic disease of the liver marked by degeneration of cells, inflammation, and fibrous thickening of tissue. It is typically a result of alcoholism or hepatitis.
- 4. condition in a child that results from alcohol exposure during the mother's pregnancy.
