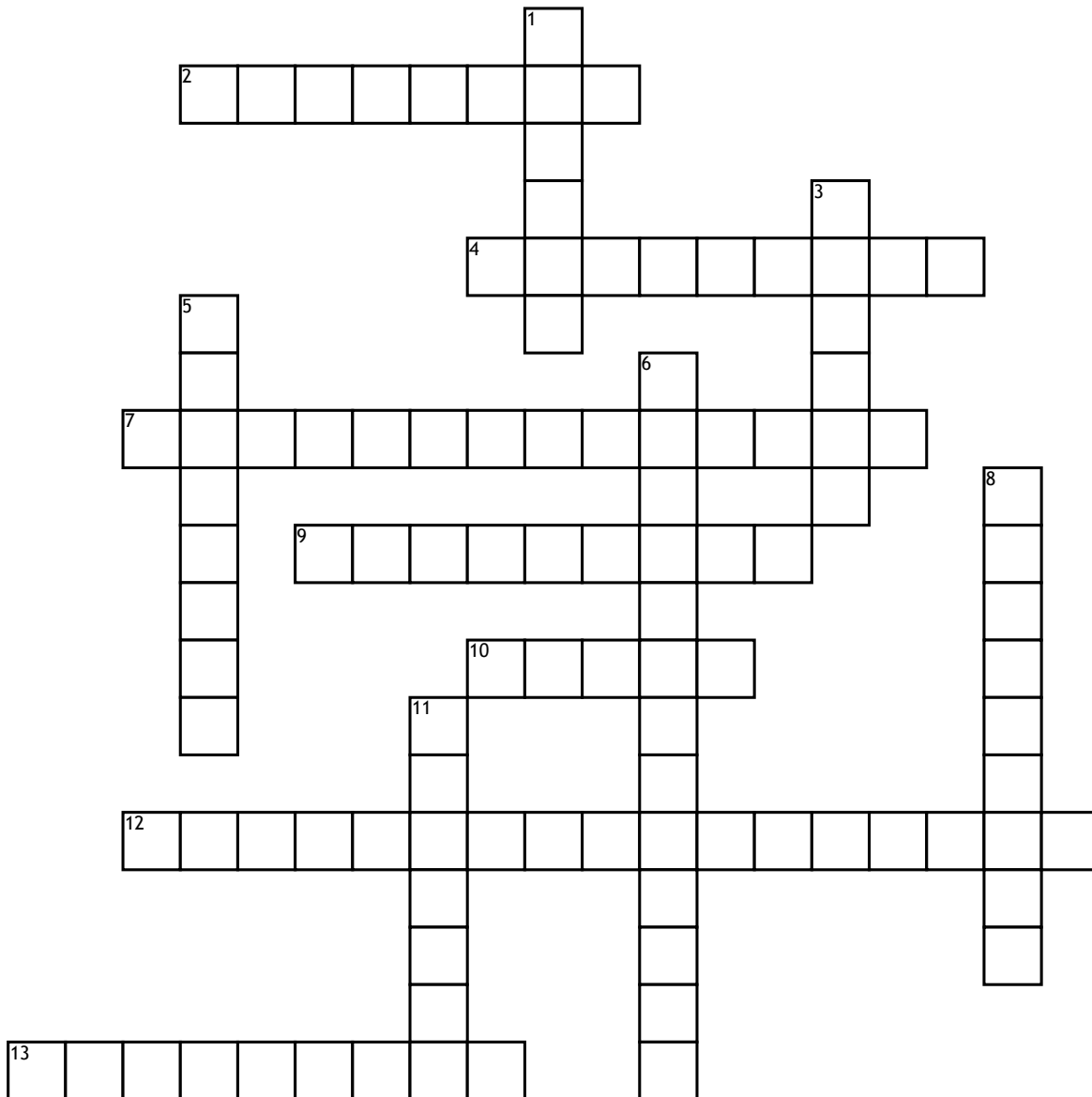


Hair, Skin, and Nails
