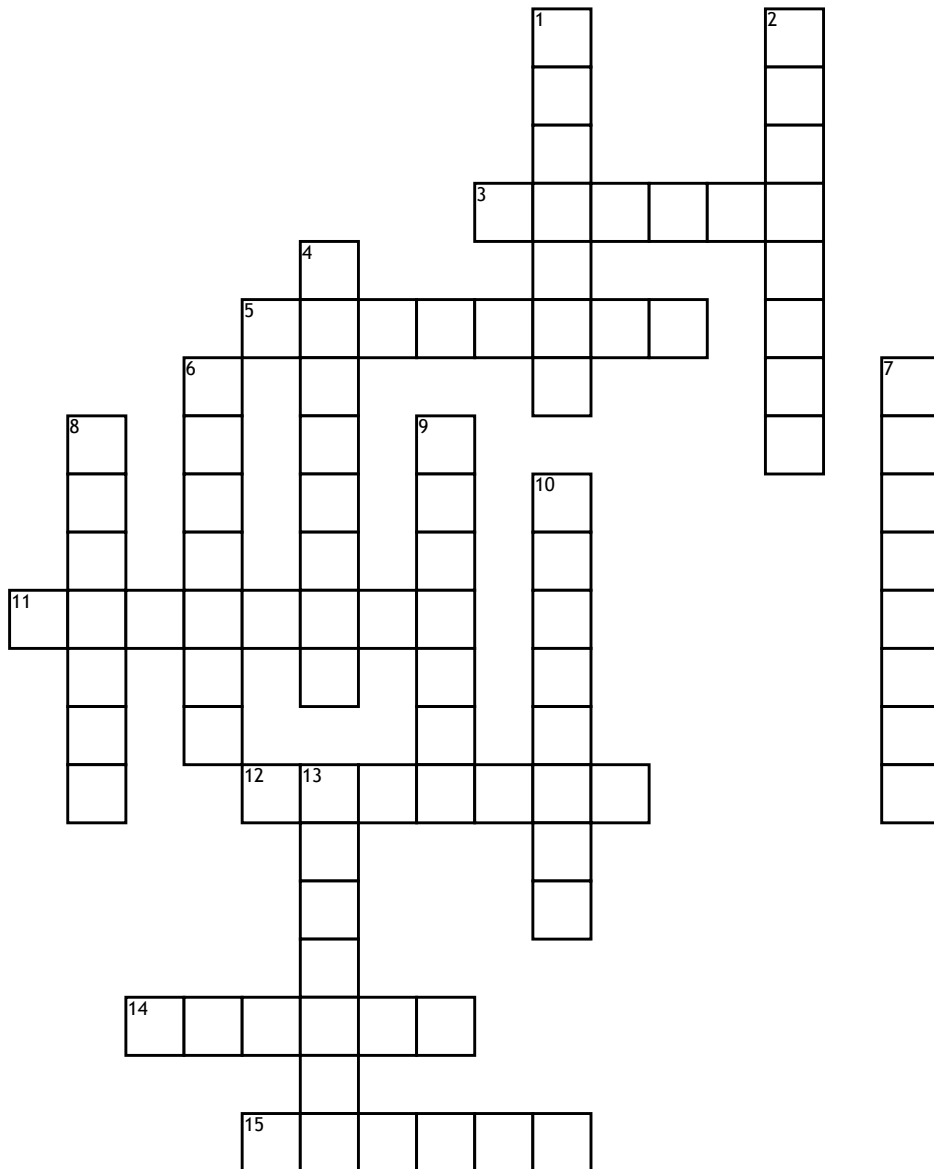


# Hamlet: Which Character
