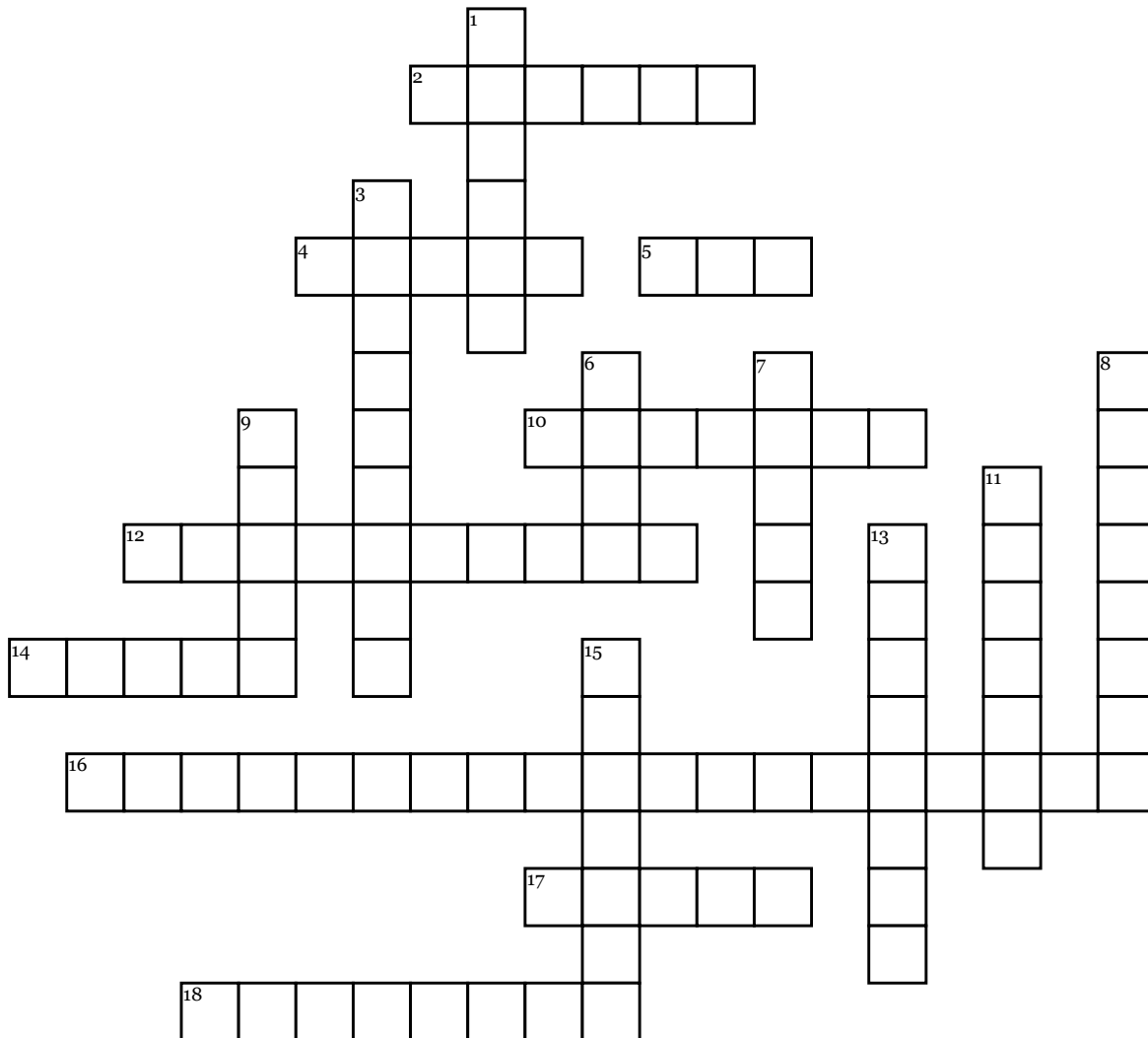


# Harriet Tubman
