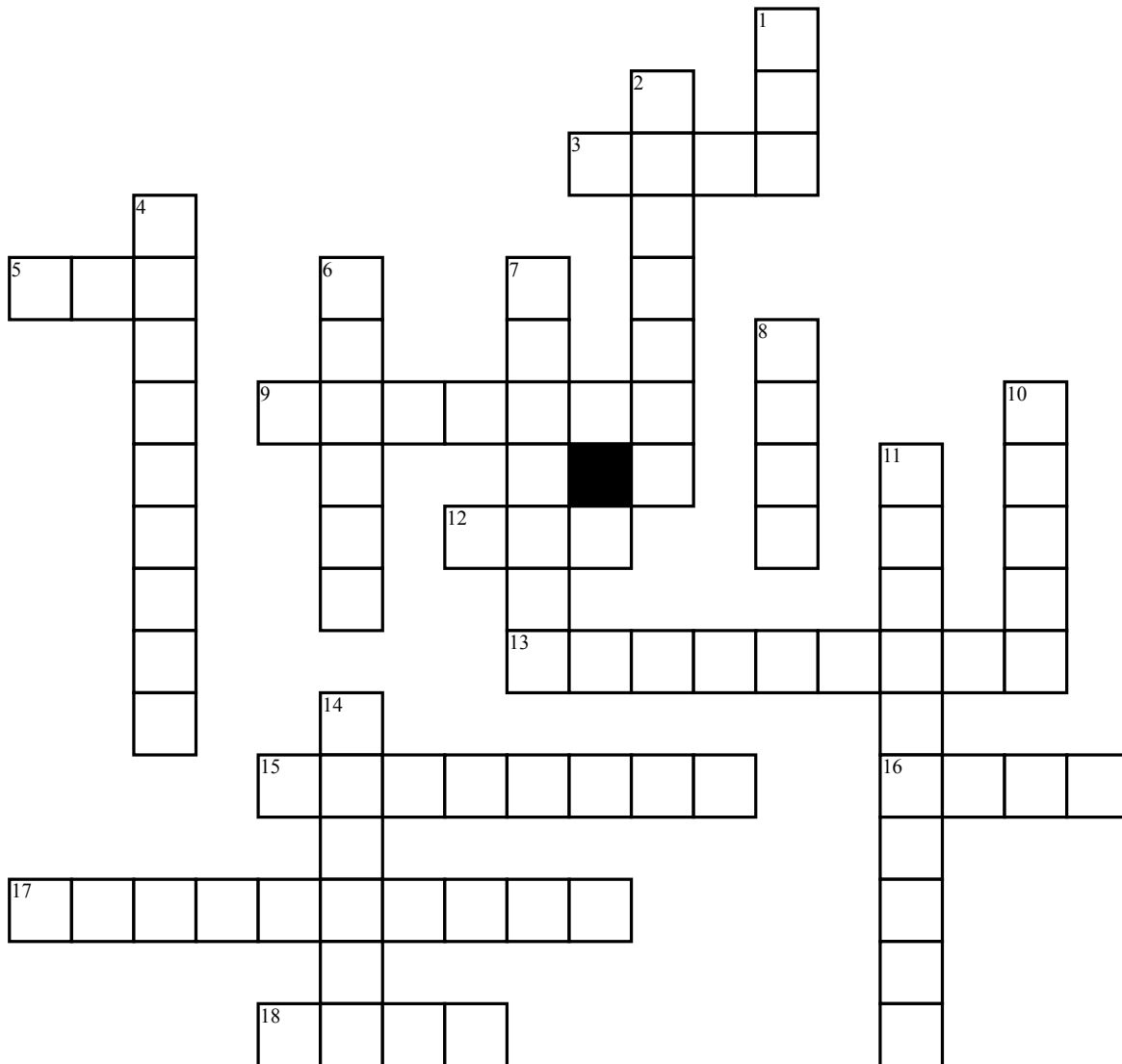


Hawaiian Islands
