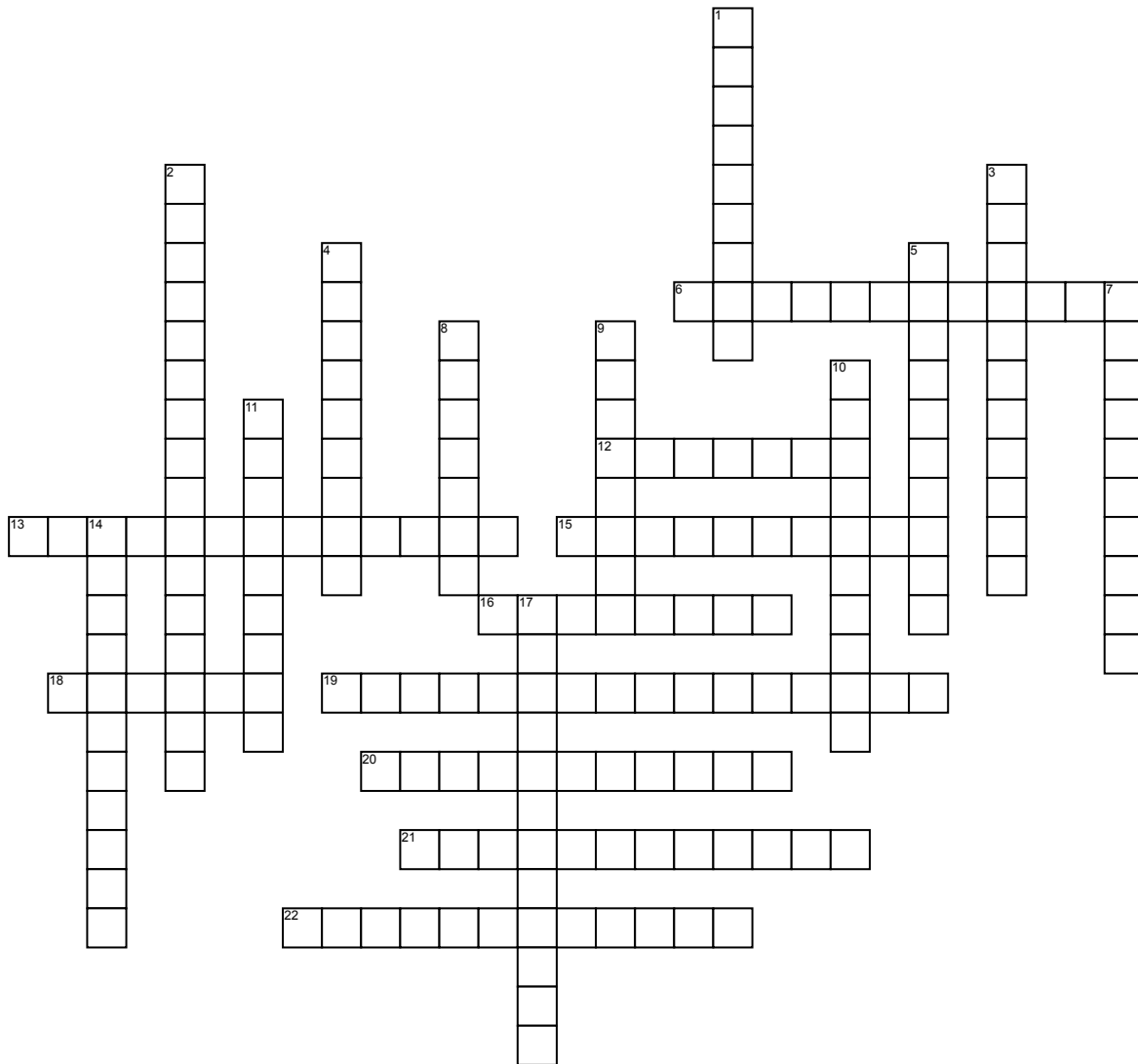


Hematopoietic and Lymphatic System
