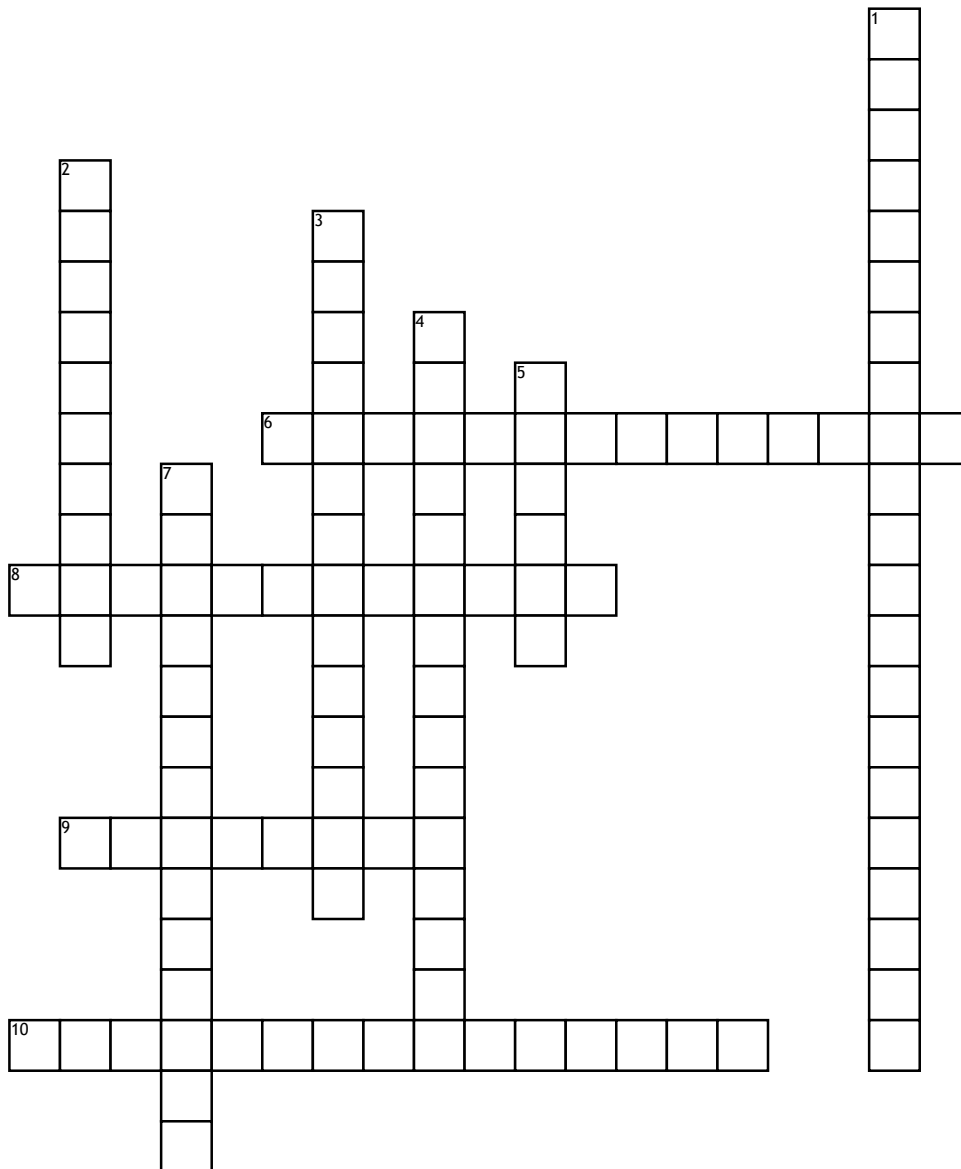


# High School and Career Planning skills
