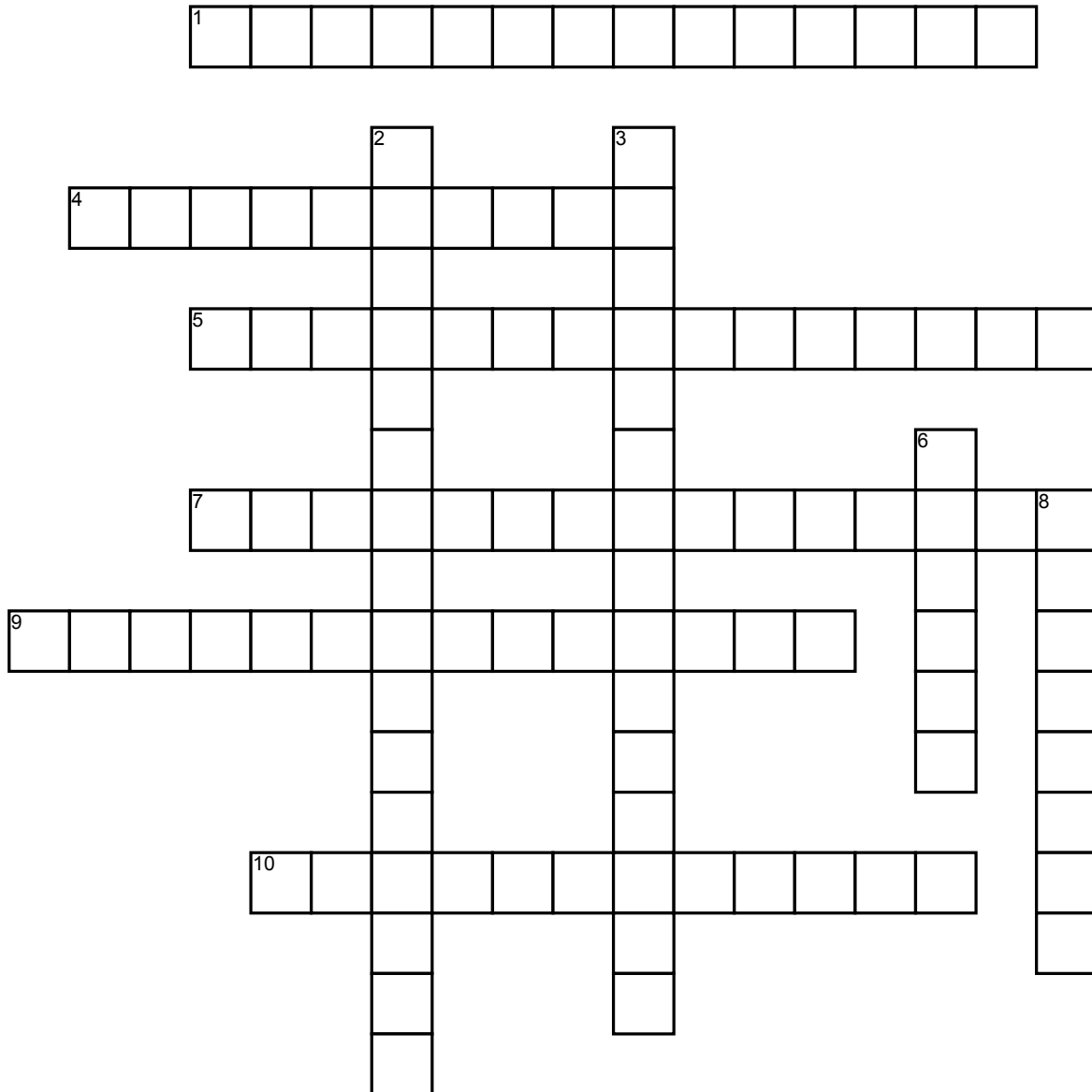


# High School and Career Planning Skills
