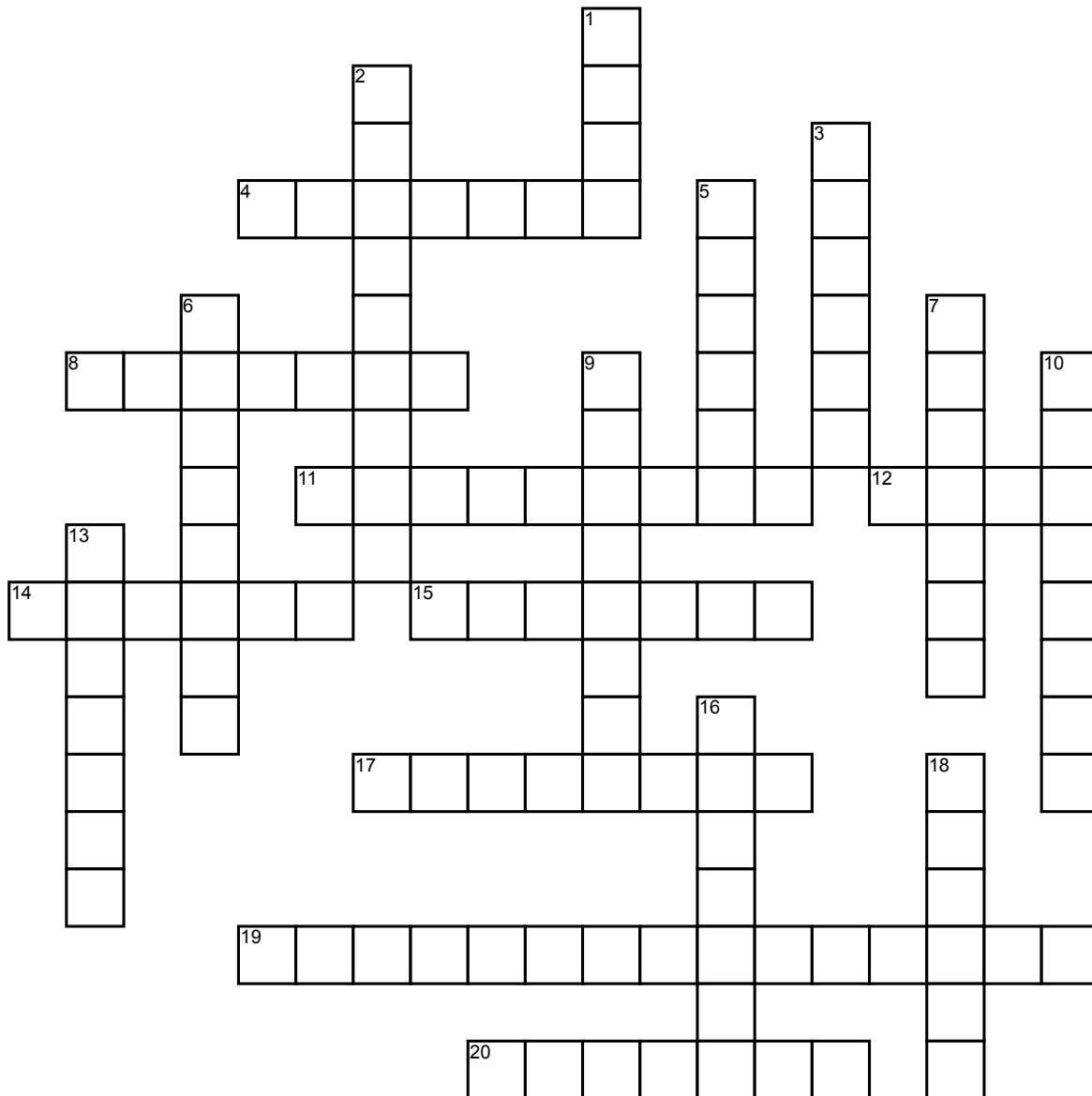


Historical Crossword
