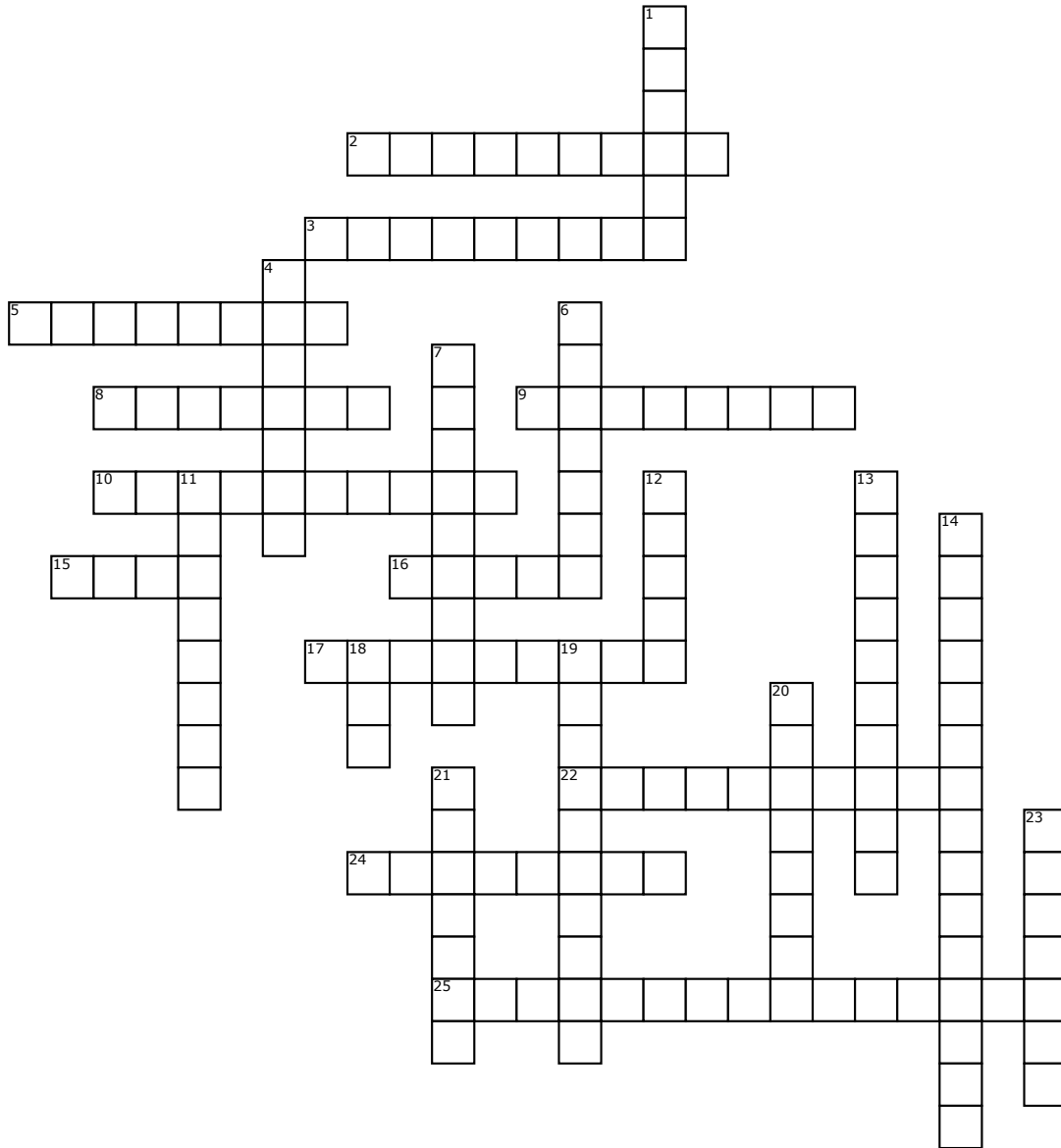


History Crossword Puzzle
