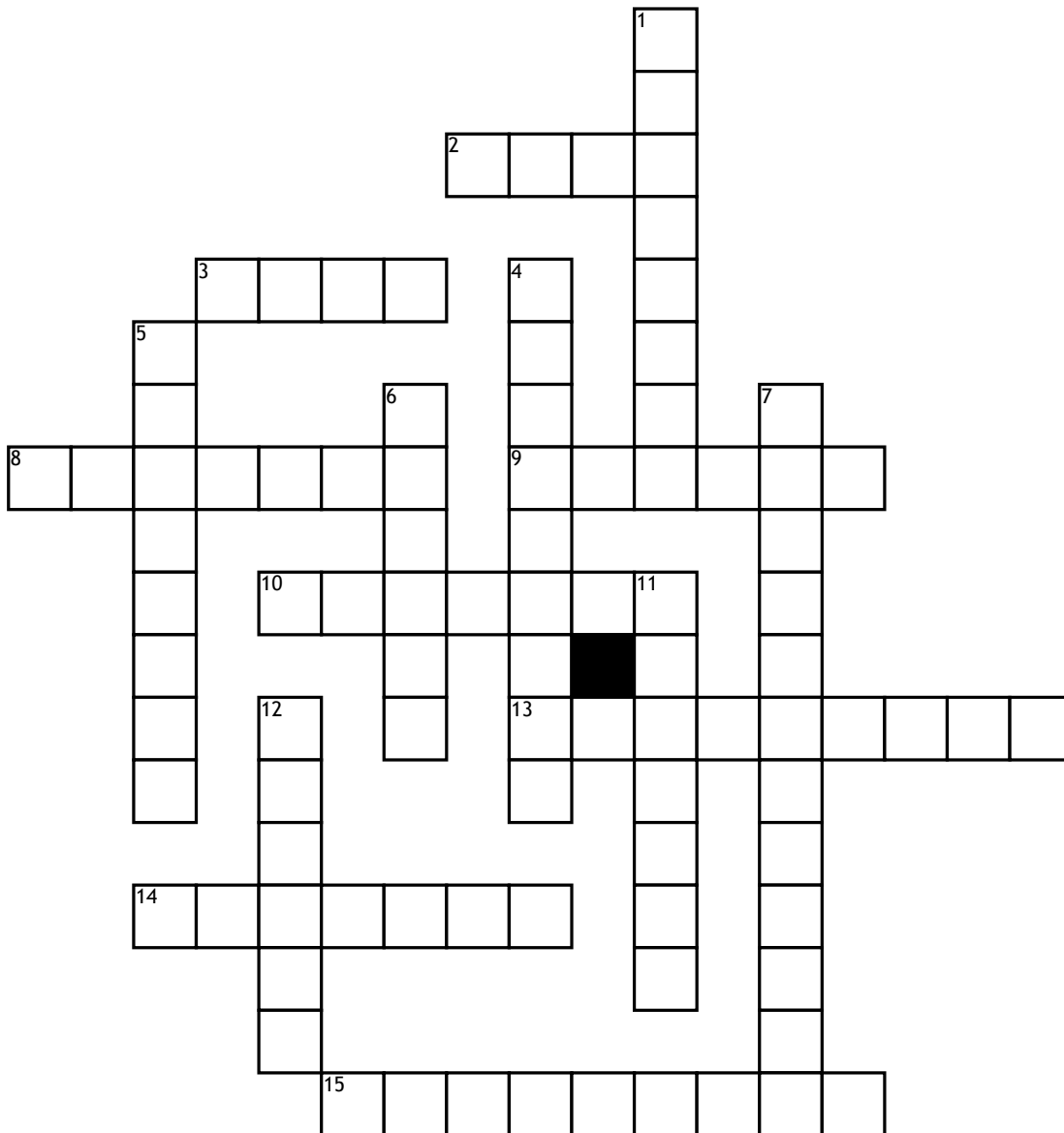


History of Eyeglasses
