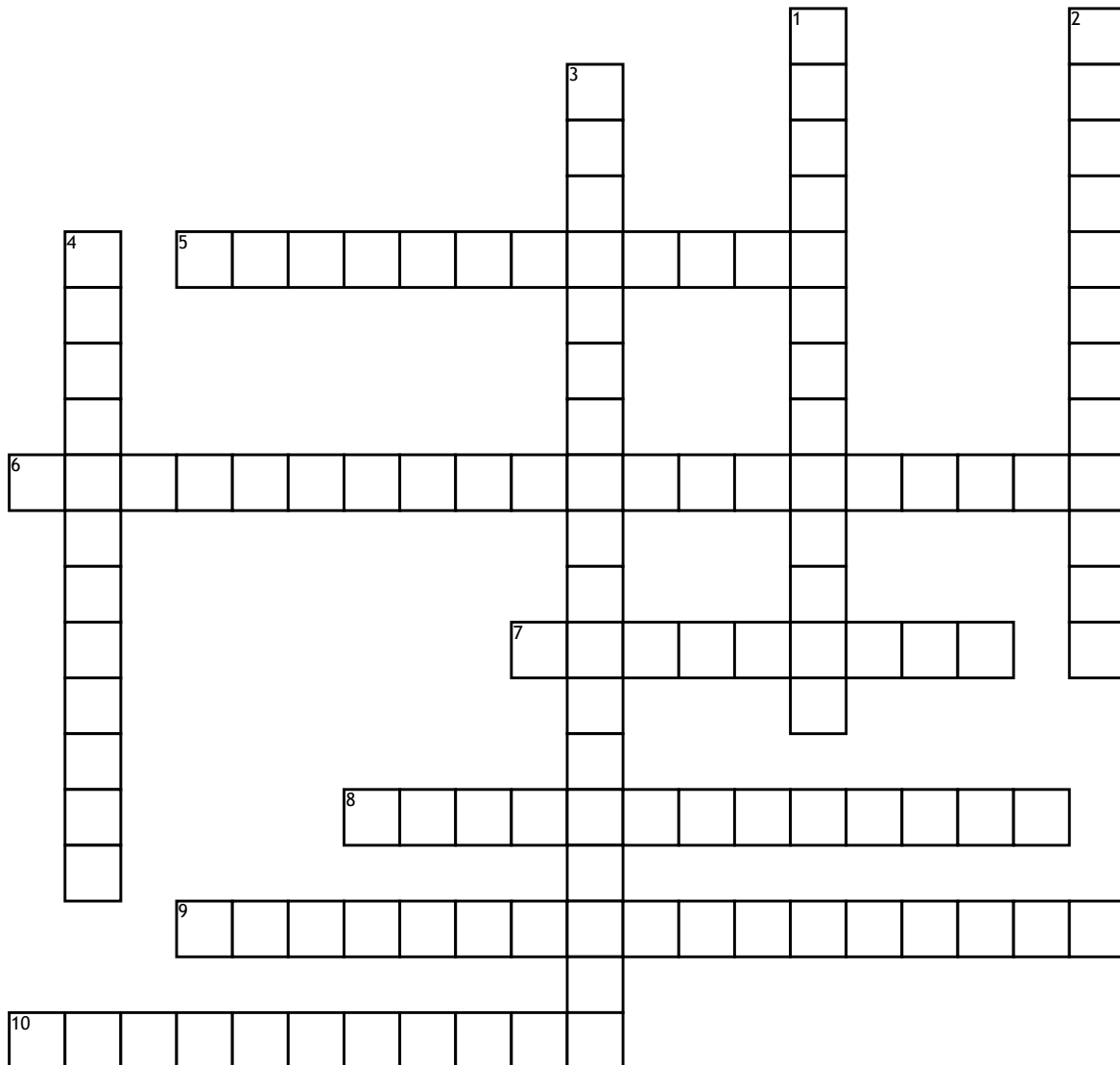


Hockett's Design Features of Human Language

5. Language can reference things that are not present in time/space
6. We learn the language we are exposed to
7. Language allows units of the same kind to be nested within other units of the same kind
8. Language combines smaller meaningful units into larger meaningful units
9. All communication systems must serve a useful purpose

10. All signals must have a meaning or function

1. Meaning associated with a word is arbitrary
2. Units of language are separate and distinct
3. Possible to send and receive the same message
4. Language can be used to say things that have never been said before, but are understandable
