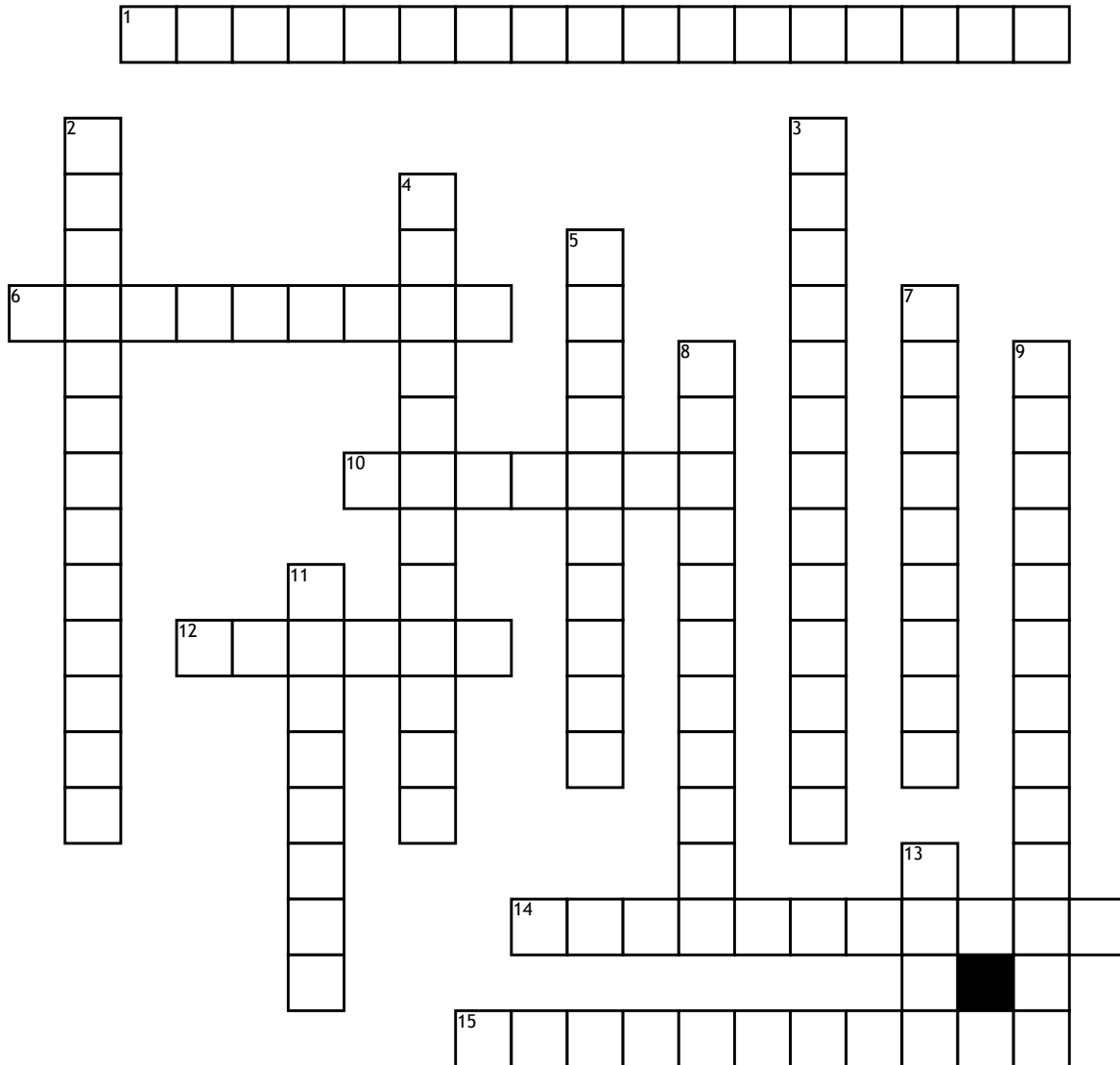


Holocaust Crossword

6. The largest of the Nazi concentration and death camps.

10. The secret police of the Nazi state.

12. Enclosed districts that isolated Jews by separating them from the non-Jewish population.

14. A six-pointed figure made up of two interlaced triangles. Used as a Jewish and Israeli symbol.

15. Hostility and ill-treatment, especially because of race or political or religious beliefs.

2. Initially served as Adolf Hitler's bodyguards, and later became one of the most powerful and feared organizations in Nazi Germany.

3. An incident where Nazis torched synagogues, vandalized Jewish homes, schools, and businesses and killed close to 100 Jews.

4. Hostility to or prejudice against the Jewish.

5. Information, especially of biased or misleading nature, used to promote a particular political cause or point of view.

7. The mass murder of Jews and member of other persecuted groups by the Nazis between 1941-45.

8. Responsible for leading the Nazi Party and the attempted genocide of the Jewish and other persecuted groups.

9. A euphemism used to describe the Nazis' plan to annihilate the Jewish people.

11. The deliberate killing of a large group of people, especially those of a particular ethnic group or nation.

13. A member of the National Socialist German Workers' Party.
