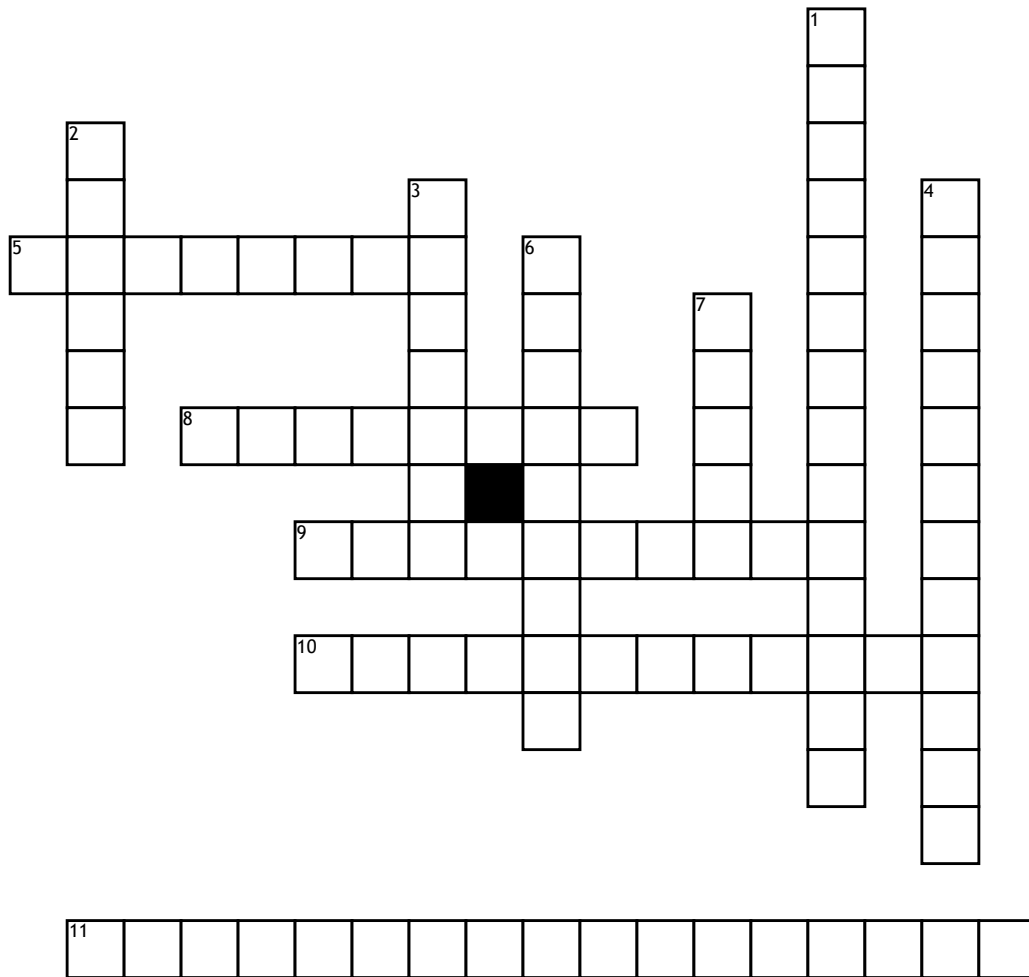


Holocaust Unit Vocabulary
