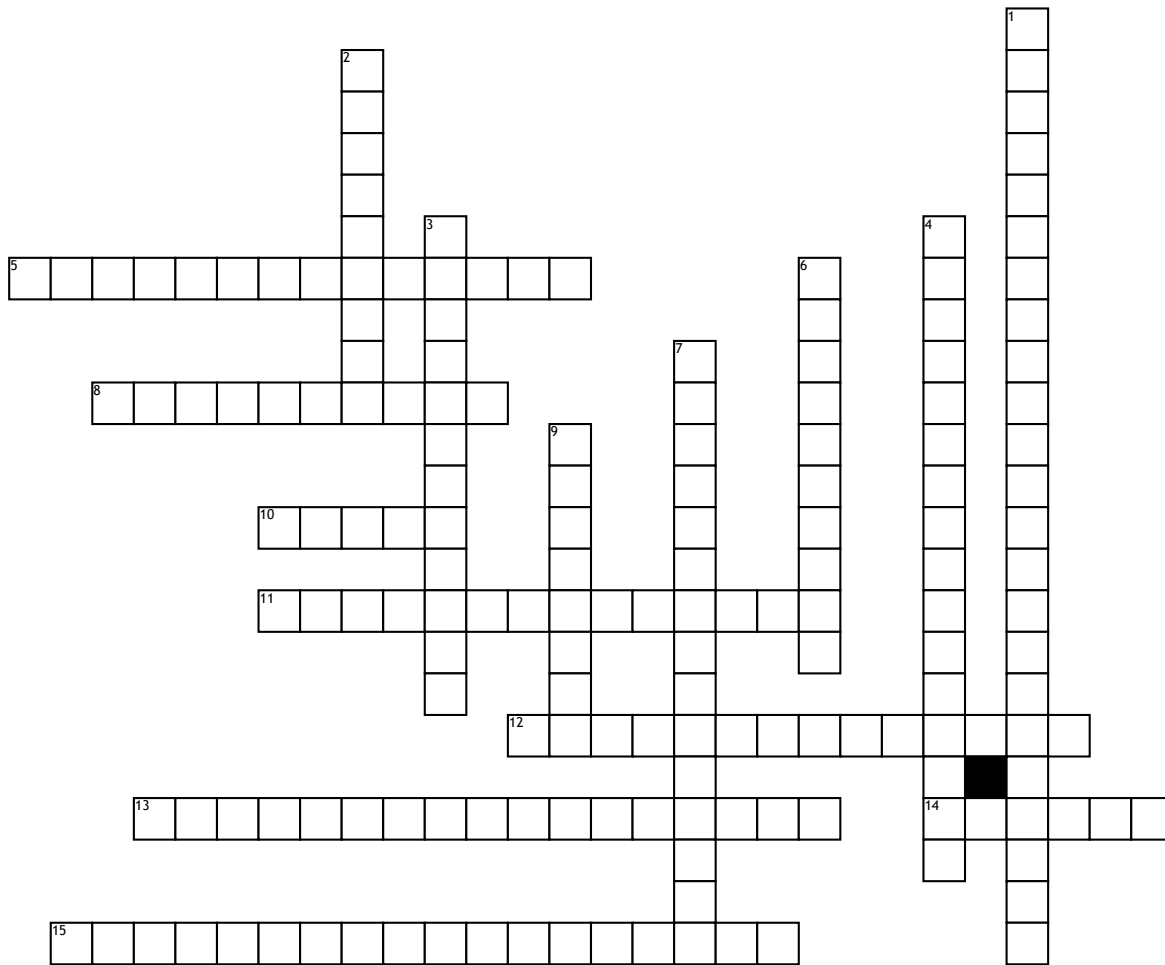

1. First written constitution of the U.S
