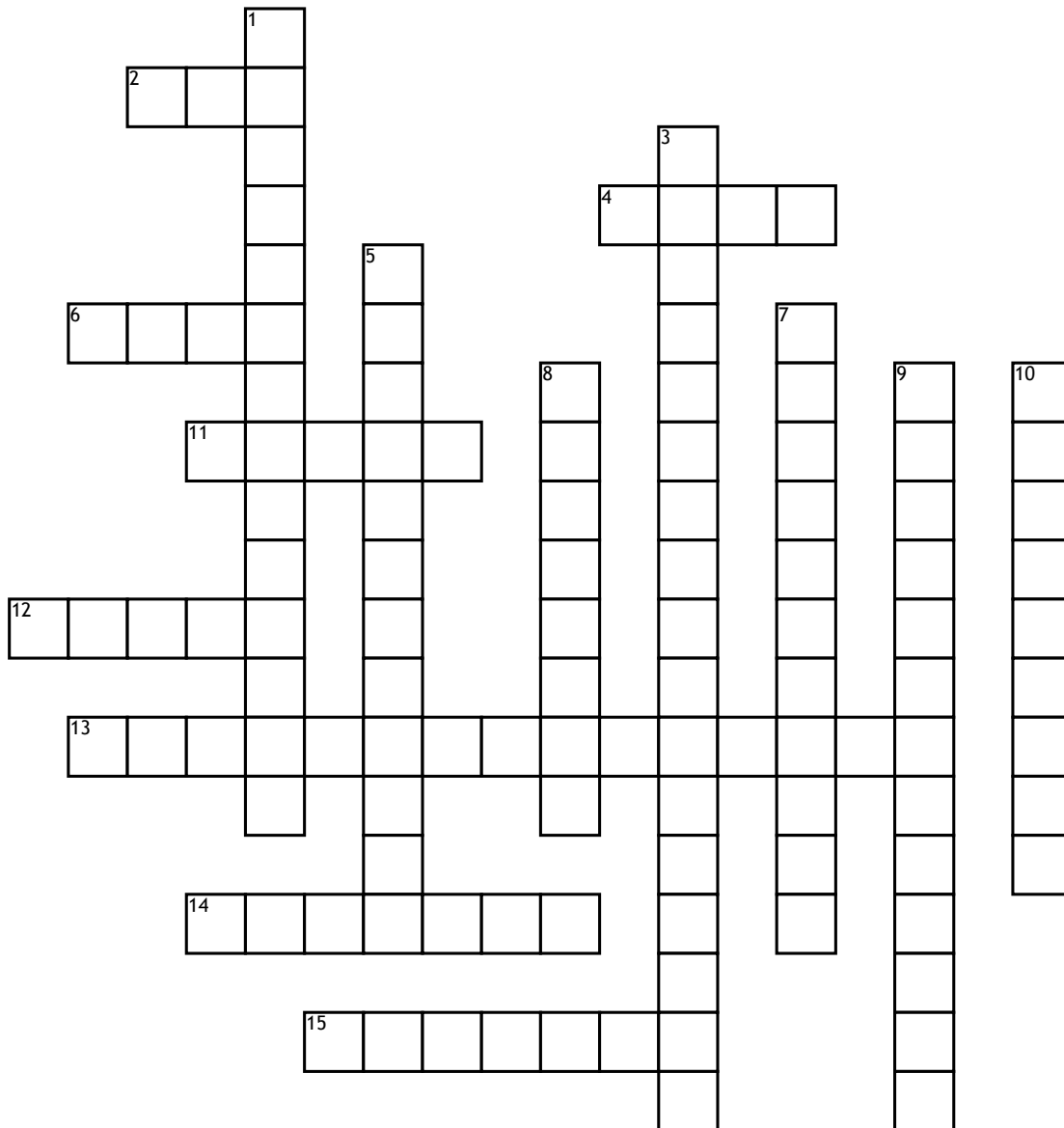

2. a highly contagious viral infection of the respiratory system

4. acquired immunodeficiency syndrome; is a viral disease that attacks the cells in the immune system making the body unable to fight off other pathogens that may attack the body

6. the smallest unit of an organism that can perform life functions; may be specialized such as nerve, blood, or bone cells

11. a structure made up of different types of tissues that work together to do a specific job; e.g. the heart is made of muscle and connective tissue

12. an illness caused by a viral infection located in the respiratory system

13. the body system that takes in, breaks down, and absorbs nutrients that are necessary for growth and maintenance; major organs include mouth, esophagus, stomach, small intestines, large intestines, rectum/anus

14. similar type cells that perform the same function (e.g. all muscle tissue contracts); four types - nerve, muscle, epithelial, connective

15. condition in which the normal function of some part of the body is disturbed

1. the body system that supports the body and enables it to move; major organs include skeletal muscles, smooth muscles, cardiac muscles

3. the body system responsible for carrying materials through out the body; major organs include heart, blood vessels

5. a group of two or more organs working together for a specific job; e.g. the digestive system

7. the body system in which oxygen is brought into the body and carbon dioxide is released; major organs include nose, trachea, bronchi, lungs, diaphragm

8. tiny organisms that cause infectious diseases; may be bacteria, viruses, fungi, or protists

9. the body system that covers and protects the body; major organ is the skin

10. the body system that helps rid the body of wastes, toxins, and excess water or nutrients; major organs include kidneys, ureters, bladder, urethra
