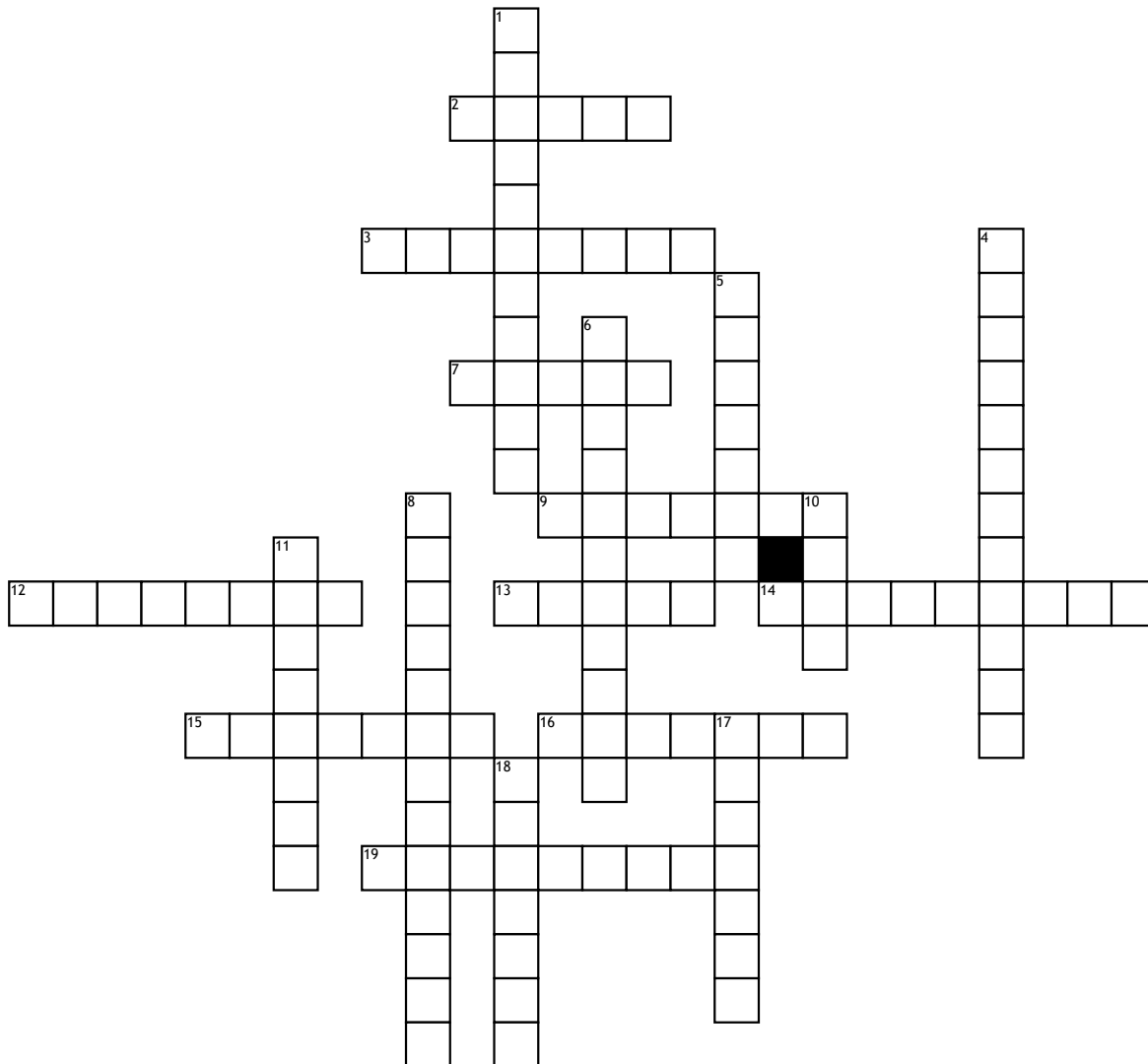


Human Body System
