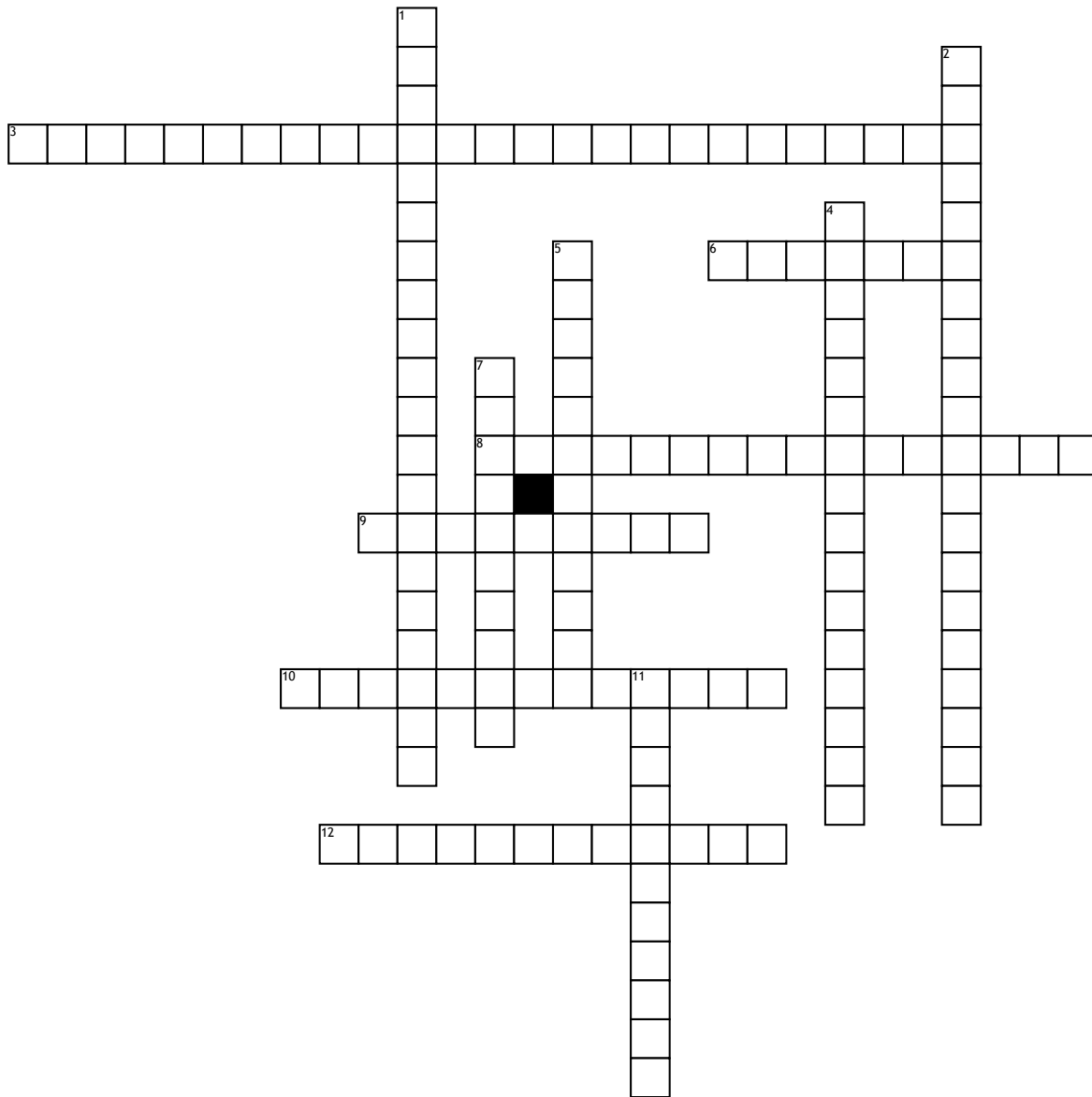

- 3. Acute, subacute, or chronic infection of the uterus, fallopian tubes, or ovaries
- 6. Usually the etiology of endometriosis
- 8. When a fertilized ovum implants and grows outside the uterine cavity
- 9. Cessation of menses, usually occurring in women between the ages of 45-55

- 10. appearance and growth of endometrial tissue outside the endometrium
- 12. Inflammation of the epididymis due to infection

- 1. An STD that can be asymptomatic for an individual
- 2. Distinct cluster of symptoms that occur 3-14 days before onset of menstruation

- 4. symptoms in men can be dribbling upon urination, urinary frequency, and incontinence
- 5. Treatment for this disease is commonly a lumpectomy or mastectomy
- 7. Absence of menstrual cycle (menarche)
- 11. Surgical removal of the testis
