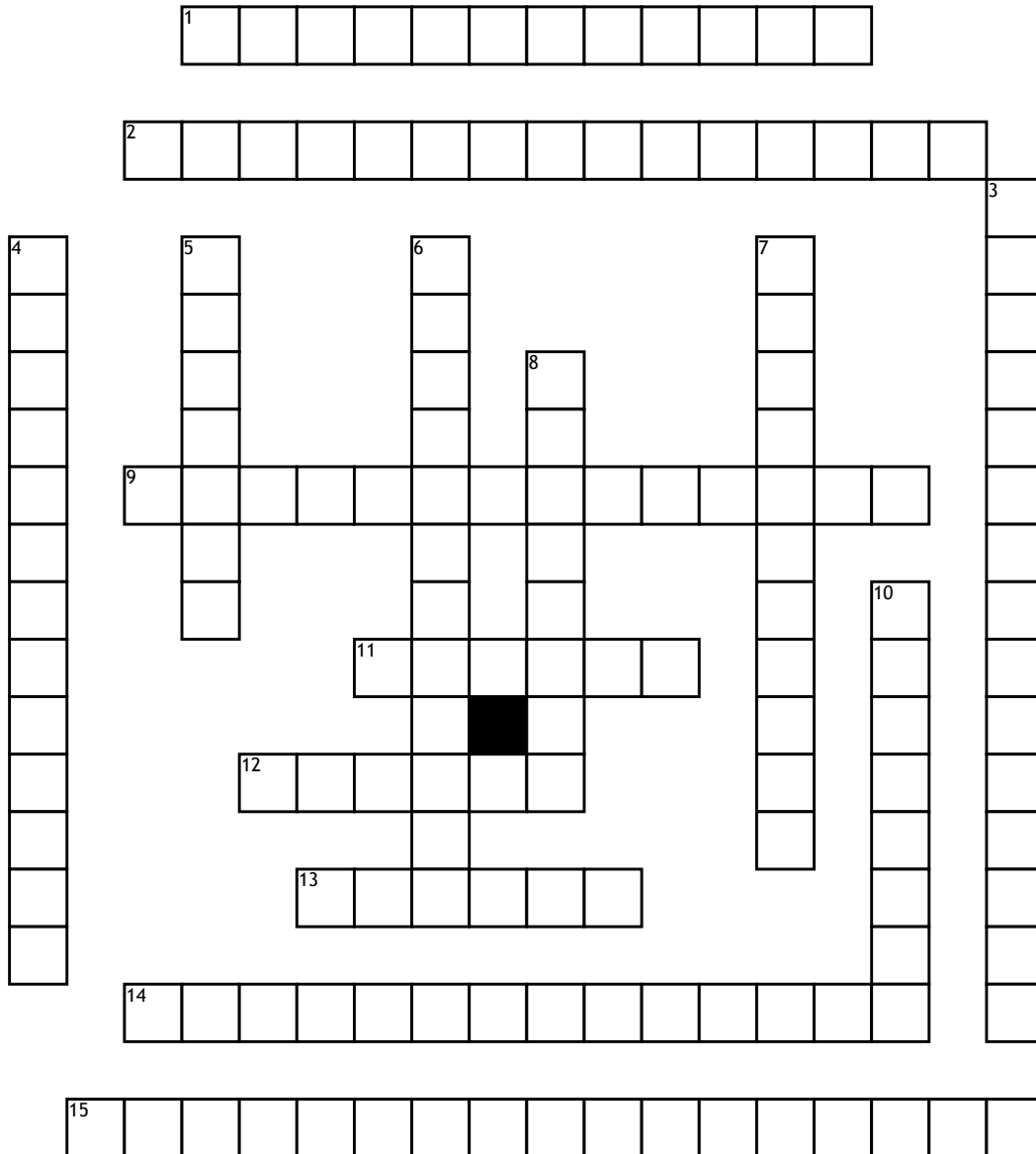


Human Endocrine System Review Crossword

- 1. Endocrine gland that surrounds the trachea in the neck and regulates your metabolism and the use of energy.
- 2. Consists of glands that control many of the body's activities by producing hormones.
- 9. The endocrine system's most influential gland. Under the influence of the hypothalamus, this gland regulates growth and controls other endocrine glands.
- 11. A cell, a group of cells, or an organ that produces a secretion for use elsewhere in the body or in a body cavity or for elimination from the body.
- 12. An immune organ located near the heart. It is the site of T cell maturation and is larger in children and adolescents.

- 13. Produce sperm cells and hormones in males
 - 14. Secrete chemical substances into ducts that lead either to other organs or out of the body.
 - 15. Any one of four endocrine glands situated above or within the thyroid gland.

- 3. Ductless glands that empty their hormonal products directly into the blood.
 - 4. A pair of endocrine glands just above the kidneys. secrete the hormones epinephrine (adrenaline) and norepinephrine (noradrenaline), which help to arouse the body in times of stress.
 - 5. Glands that produce the egg cells and hormones in females.

- 6. Brain region controlling the pituitary gland.
- 7. Gland that secretes the hormone melatonin to help you sleep.
- 8. Chemical messengers that are manufactured by the endocrine glands, travel through the bloodstream, and affect other tissues.
- 10. An organ in the abdominal cavity with two roles. The first is an exocrine role: to produce digestive enzymes and bicarbonate, which are delivered to the small intestine via a duct. The second is an endocrine role: to secrete insulin and glucagon into the bloodstream to help regulate blood glucose (sugar) levels.
