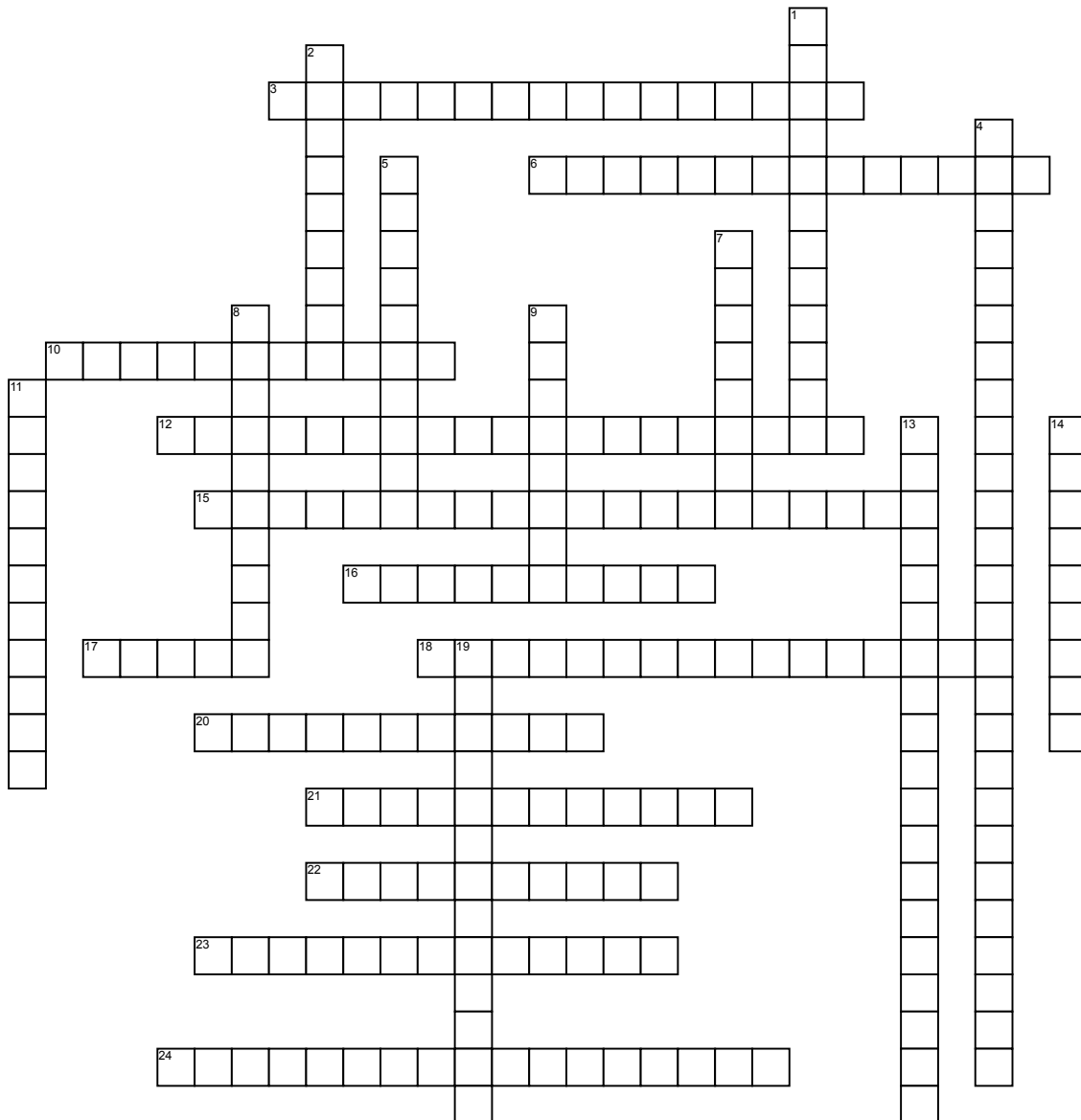


# Human Rights Crossword
