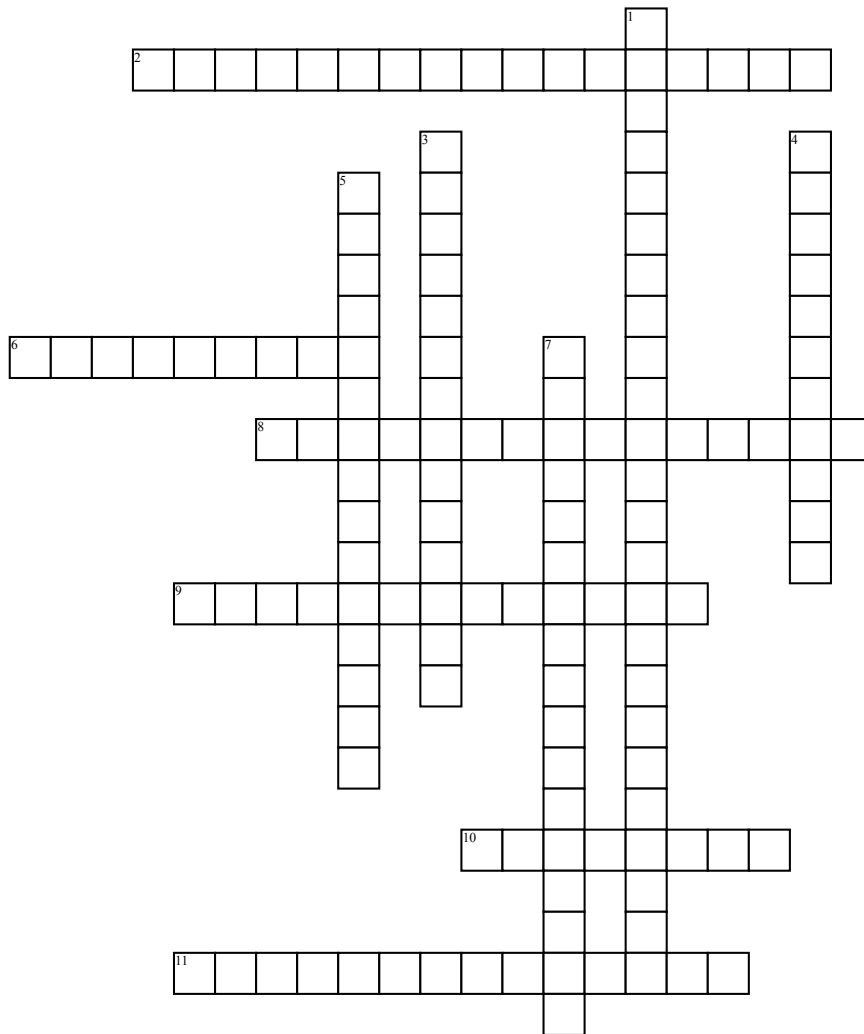


# Human Rights and Globalization Crossword
