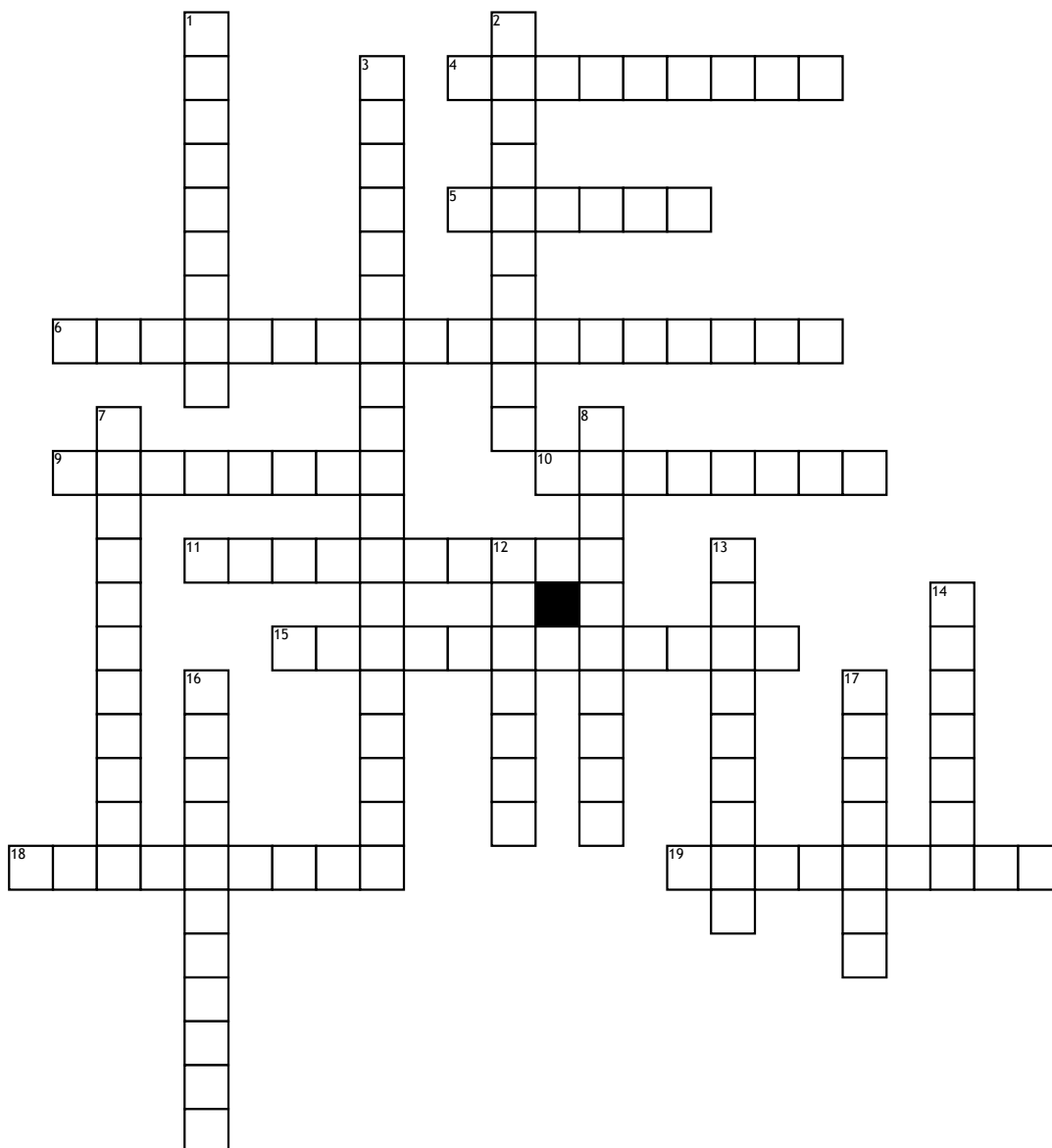


# Humanities Crossword
