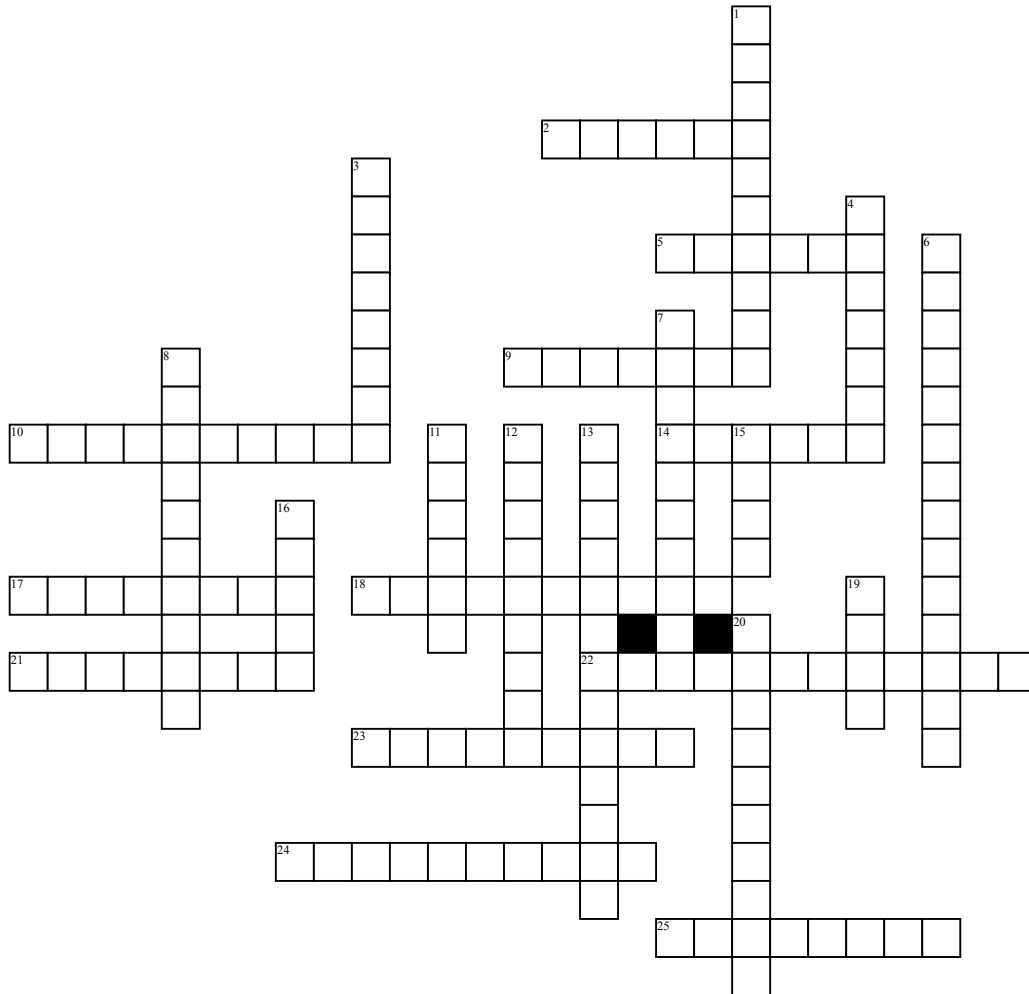


# Hunger Games Crossword
