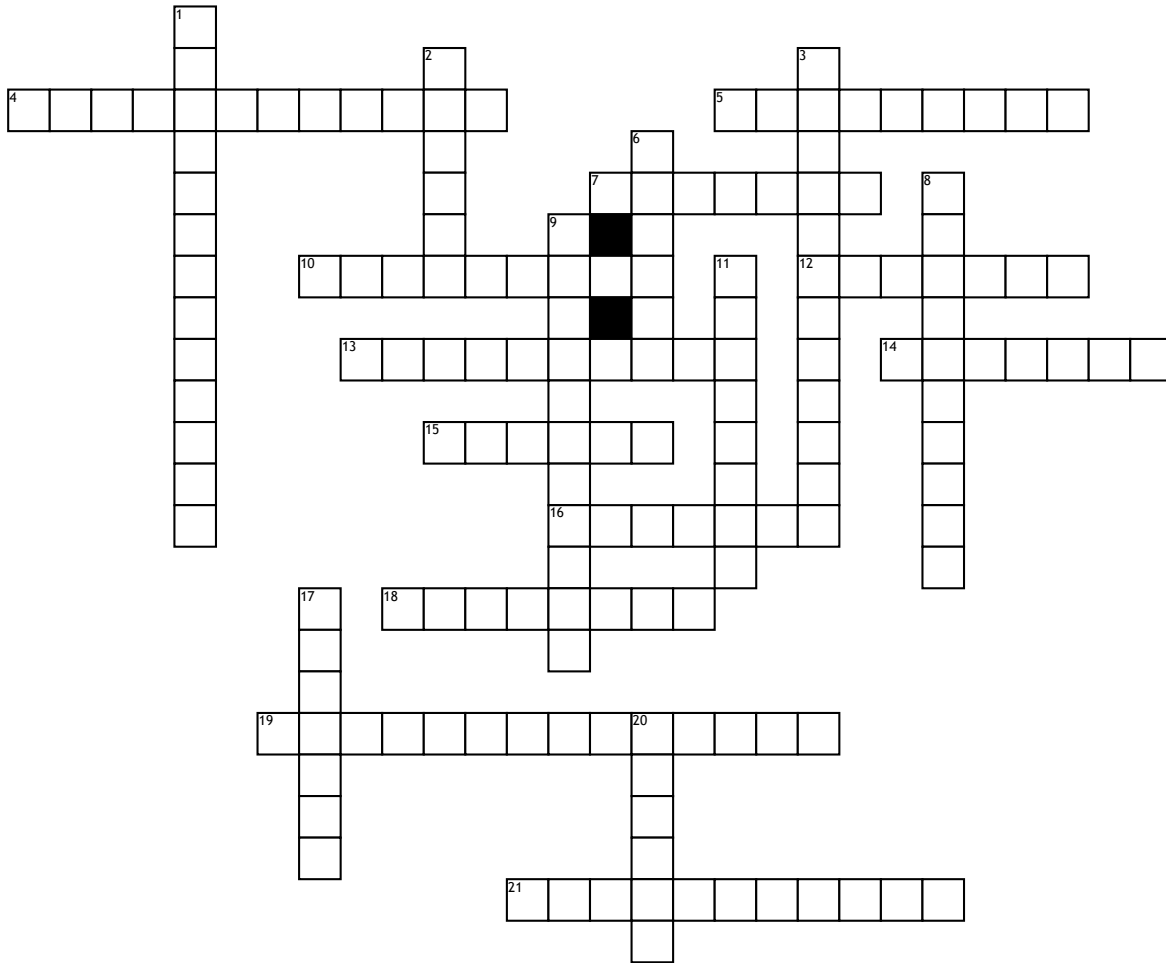


# Hydrosphere. Biosphere.

- 4. Zone that does not receive any sunlight.
- 5. Biome characterized by large, rolling terrains of grasses
- 7. Region in which the sea bottom is exposed during low tide and is covered during high tide.
- 10. Sphere that contains the entirety of Earth's living things
- 12. It is the world's largest ocean.
- 13. Zone that divides the ocean from land to the sea.
- 14. Division of the pelagic zone that begins from the low tide mark and extends up to the edge of the seaward side of the continental shelf.

- 15. This biome's climate is extreme depending on it's location
- 16. Biome that includes the freshwater and marine regions
- 18. Zone that divides the ocean based on depth.
- 19. One of the major sources of salts in the ocean
- 21. Sphere that contains all of Earth's water

- 1. Division of the vertical zone that is described as deep sea.

- 8. Zone that gets a lot of sunlight, resulting to an abundance of aquatic plants.
- 9. A zone characterized by dim light due to the limited amount of sunlight it receives.
- 11. Refers to the proportion of dissolved salts to pure water, expressed in parts per thousand
- 17. Division of the pelagic zone that extends from the bottom edge of the neritic zone to the entire rest of the ocean.
