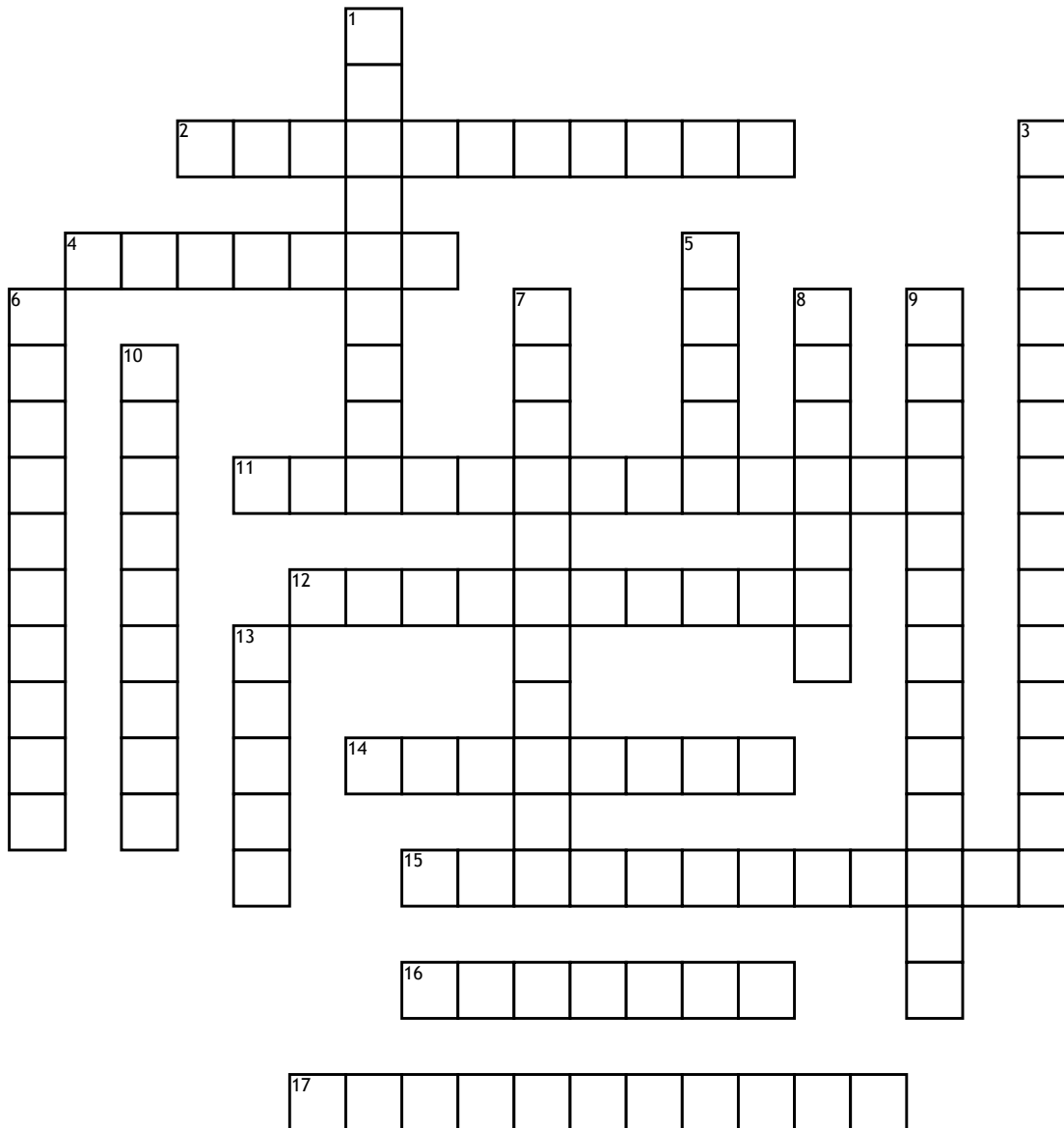


# Hydrosphere Crossword



## Across

2. Term for all of the water on Earth.
4. A bend (or curve) in the course of a river.
11. Water that falls back to Earth as rain, snow, hail, or sleet.
12. The top level of aquifer, which can change over time.
14. A measure of the amount of dissolved salts in a certain volume of water.
15. Change in state from a gas to a liquid, such as when clouds form.
16. Where fresh water from rivers mixes with salty ocean water, such as at a bay, inlet, lagoon, or salt marsh.

17. Materials that do not have connected pores and do not allow water to move through.

## Down

1. Material that has pores that are connected and allows water to move through.
3. The process where nutrients build up in a body of water, causing algae to overgrow. This consumes all of the oxygen in the water and many aquatic organisms cannot survive.
5. A landform (or island) of sediment formed at the mouth of a river.
6. The continuous process where water moves from the surface to the atmosphere and back. It is powered by solar energy.
7. The change of molecules on the surface of a liquid to a gas.
8. An underground body of water found in a layer of permeable rock or soil.
9. The evaporation of water from the leaves of a plant.
10. A small stream or river that flows into a main river.
13. Where a river flows into a larger body of water, such as a lake or the ocean.
