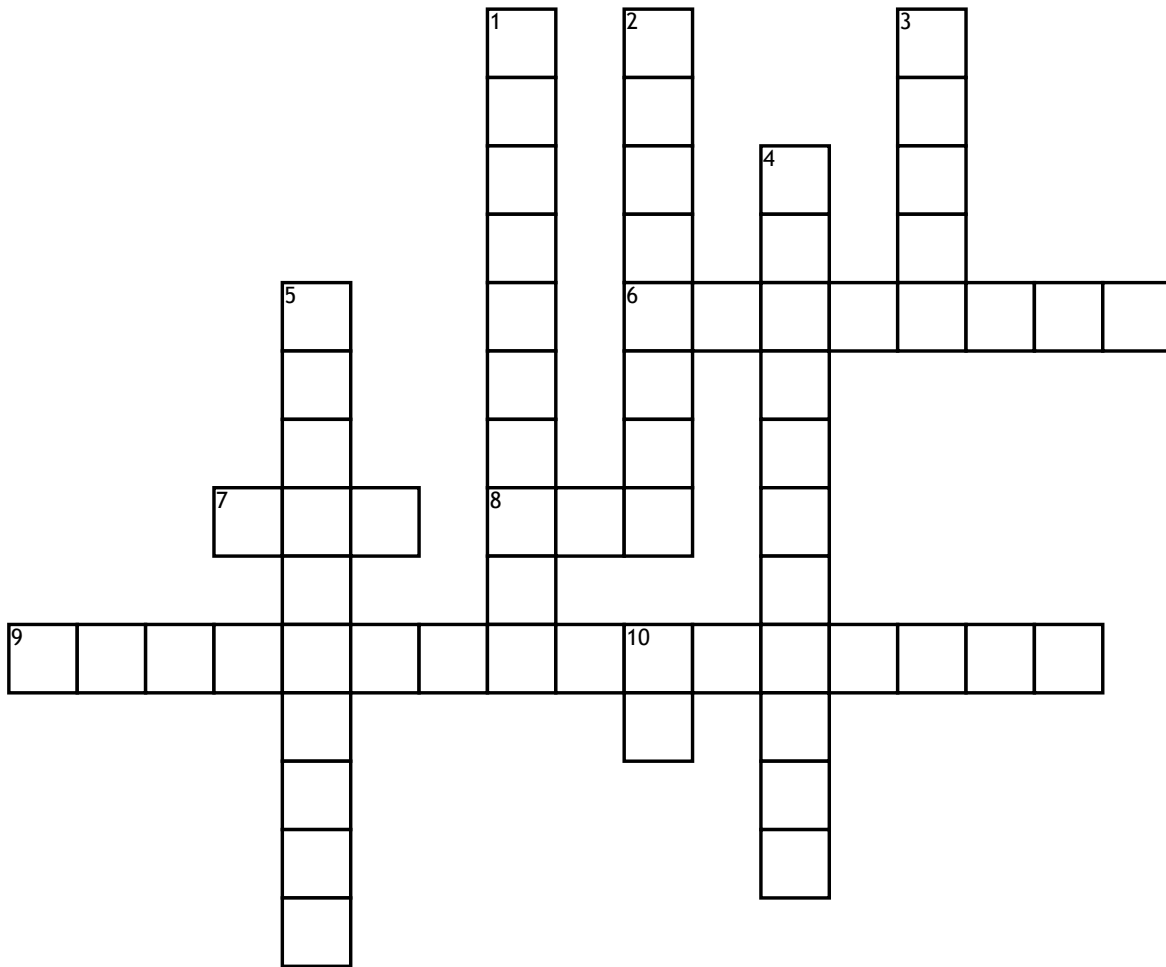


Hyperinflation Therapy

- 6. Control that regulates the amount of pressure that must build up in the breathing circuit before patient inspiration
- 7. The physiologic cost of increased dead space and resistance
- 8. The increased intrathoracic pressure combined with decreased cardiac output
- 9. Patient complaint of dizziness, light-headedness, and tingling sensation

Down

- 1. Cycles IPPB respirator on

- 2. Another term for dynamic hyperinflation
- 3. These trap air on expiration and are not capable of withstanding high pressures
- 4. Collapse of distal lung parenchyma
- 5. Hyperinflation, elevated airway pressures, and procedures lead to this harmful outcome
- 10. Modality that uses the patient's own muscular effort to accomplish hyperinflation of the lungs
