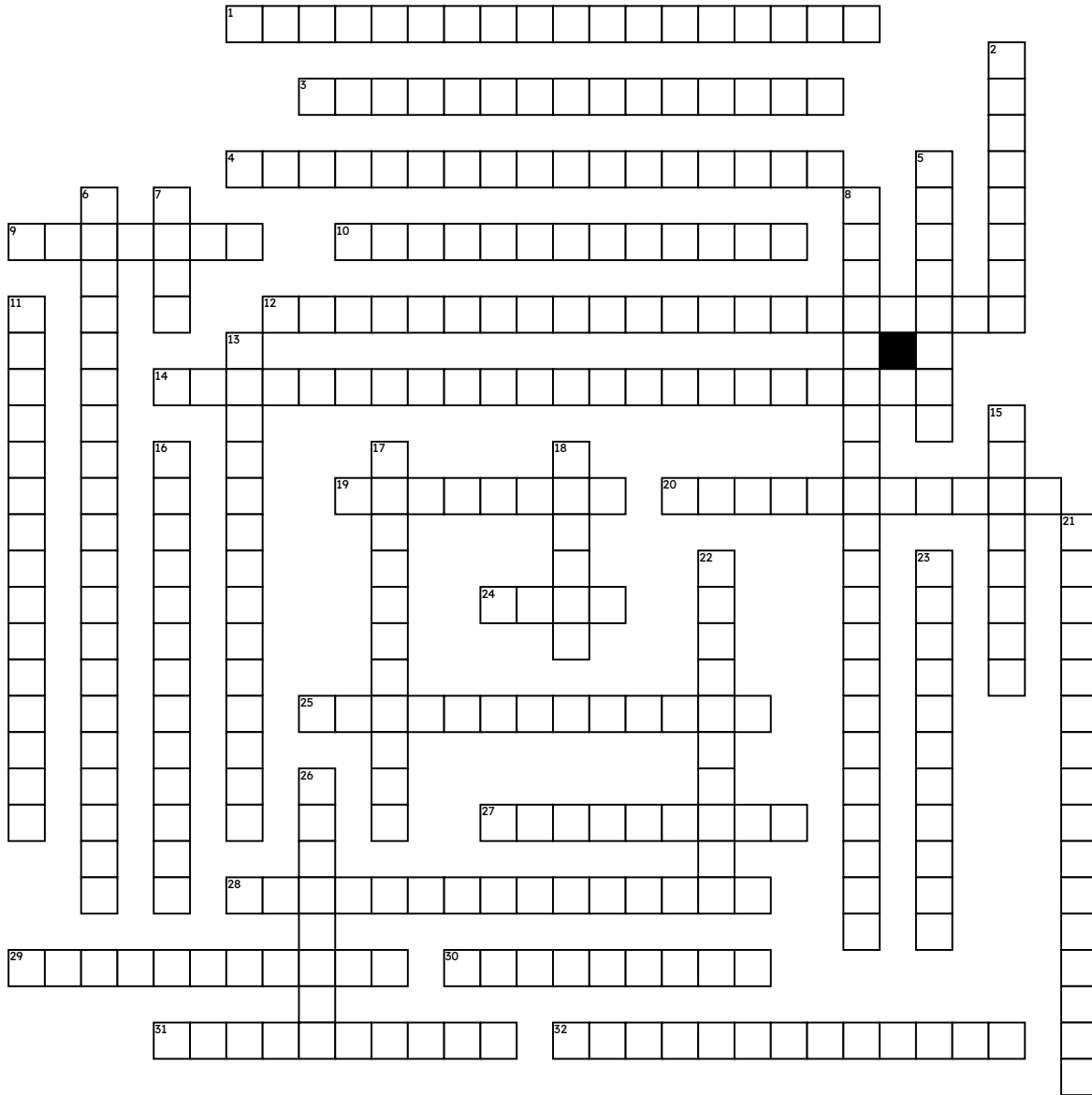

- 3. The software that supports a computer's basic functions, such as scheduling tasks, executing applications, and controlling peripherals.

- 9. The retention of retrievable data on a computer or other electronic system; memory.
- 10. A small computer that contains a microprocessor as its central processor.
- 12. A method employing encryption to provide secure access to a remote computer over the internet.
- 14. A visual way of interacting with a computer using items such as windows, icons, and menus, used by most modern operating systems.
