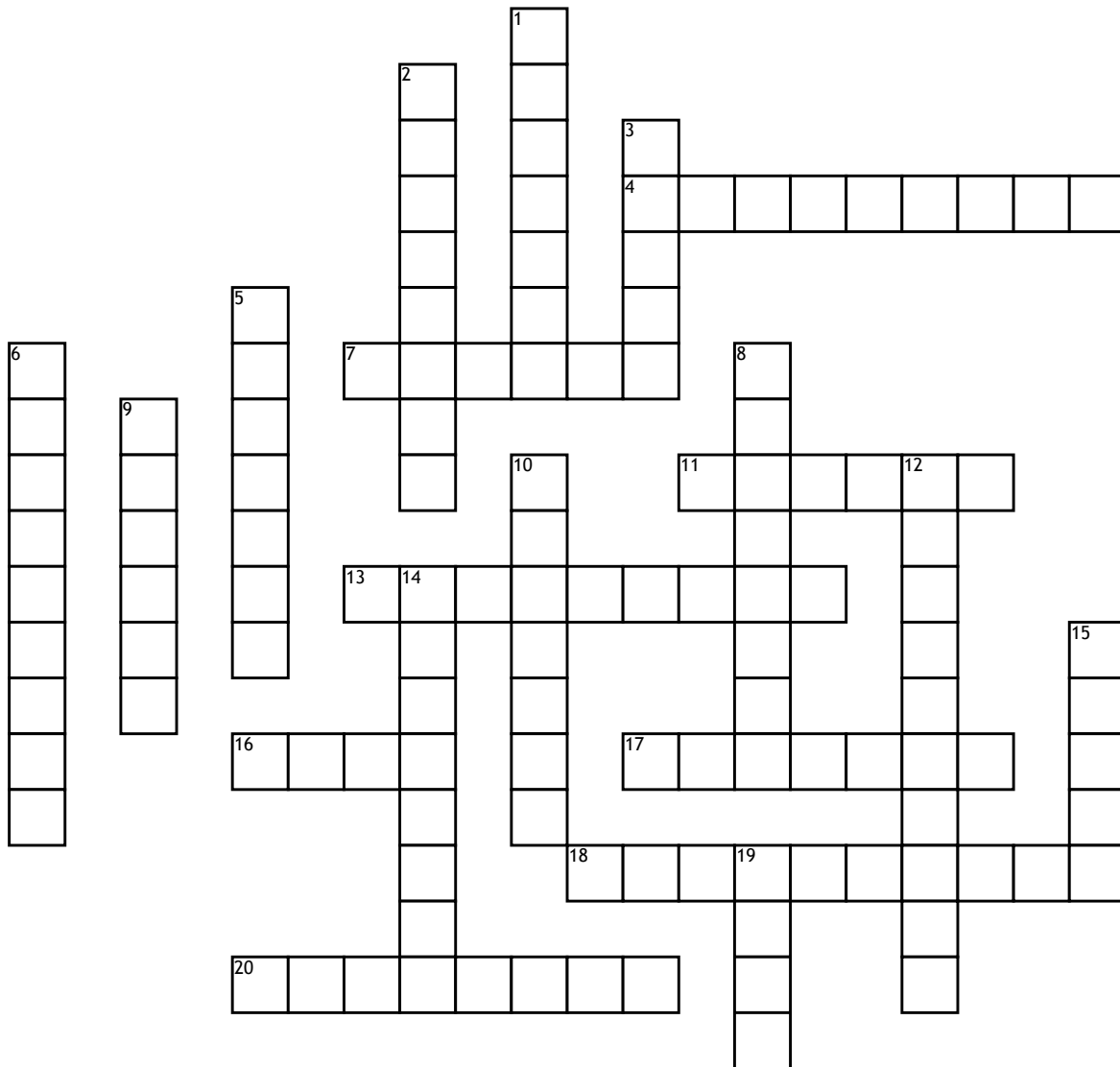


# I Survived Pearl Harbor
