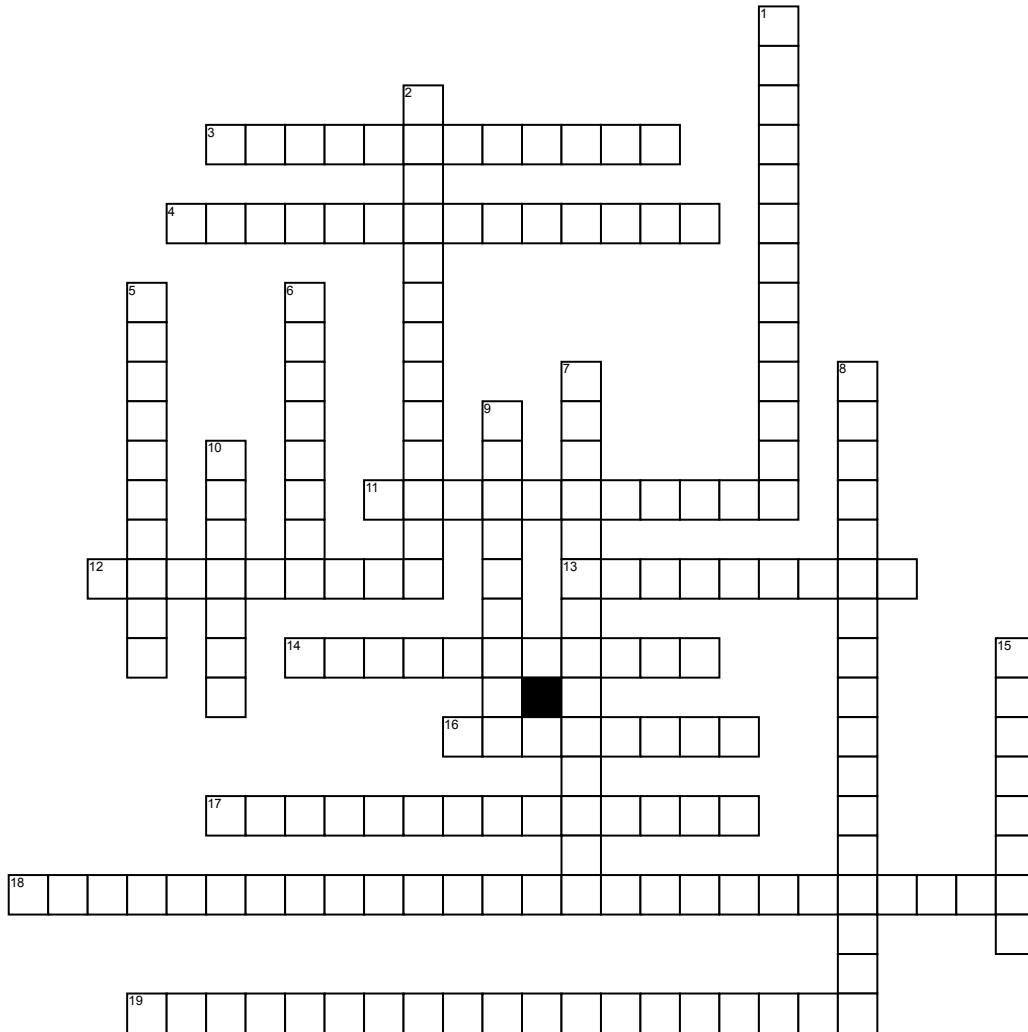

- 3. chemical substances that people of any age may not lawfully manufacture, possess, buy, or sell.
- 4. the process of medical and psychological treatment for physiological or psychological dependence on a drug or alcohol.
- 11. sedatives that are colorless, odorless, and tasteless.
- 12. substances whose fumes are sniffed or inhaled to give affect.
- 13. a physiological or psychological dependence on a drug
- 14. organized community efforts by neighborhood residents to patrol, monitor, report, and otherwise try to stop drug deals and drug abuse.

- 16. an irrational suspiciousness or distrust of others.
- 17. the use or sale of any substance that is illegal or otherwise permitted.
- 18. synthetic substances similar to male sex hormones
- 19. areas within a 1,000 to 1,500 feet of schools and designated by signs, within which people caught selling drugs receive especially severe penalties.

- 1. synthetic drugs that are made to imitate the effects of other drugs.
- 2. drugs that alter moods, thoughts, and sense perceptions, including vision, hearing, smell, and touch.

- 5. drugs that speed up the central nervous system.
- 6. a feeling of intense well-being or elation.
- 7. is any unnecessary or improper use of chemical substances for non-medical purposes.
- 8. chemicals that effect the central nervous system and alter activity in the brain.
- 9. is a plant whose leaves, buds, and flowers are usually smoked for their intoxicating effects.
- 10. narcotics, are drugs such as those derived from the opium plan that are obtainable only by prescription and are used to relieve pain.
- 15. a strong sometimes fatal reaction to taking a large amount of a drug.
