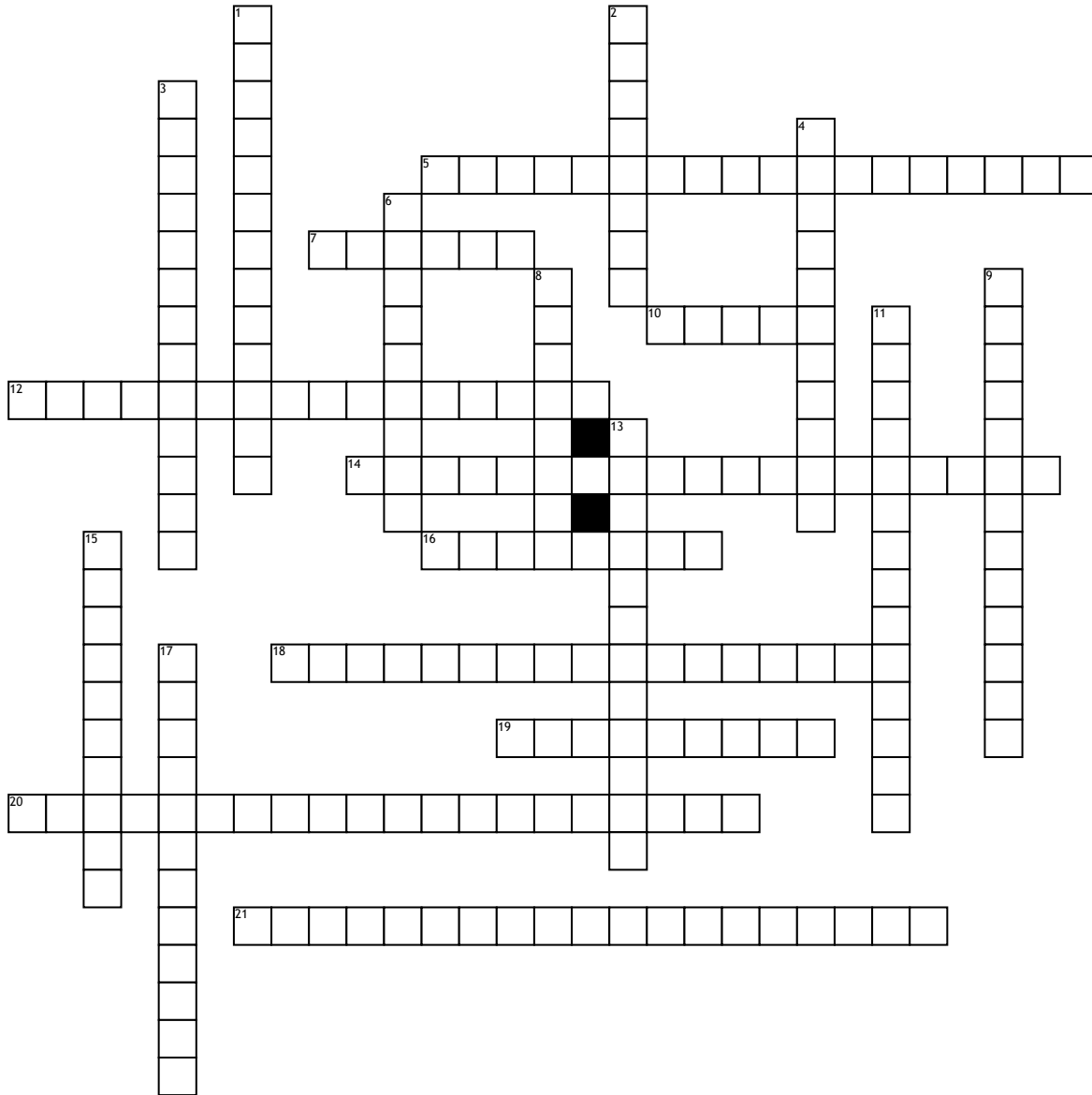

- 5. An organized campaign to eliminate alcohol consumption
- 7. a part of a city, especially a slum area, occupied by a minority group or groups.
- 10. organization of individuals associated through employment, with the purpose of maintaining or improving the conditions of their employment ORGANIZED
- 12. Established the Standard Oil Company, tycoon in oil industry
- 14. an early 20th century reform movement seeking to return control of the government to the people, to restore economic opportunities, and to correct injustices in American life
- 16. First to achieve a sustained, controlled flight in a powered airplane WRIGHT

- 18. The development of industries for the machine production of goods.
- 19. settlement house founded by Progressive reformer Jane Addams in Chicago in 1889
- 20. A prominent advocate of women's rights, organized the 1848 Seneca Falls Convention with Lucretia Mott
- 21. A railroad owner who built a railway connecting Chicago and New York. He popularized the use of steel rails in his railroad, which made railroads safer and more economical.

- 1. social reformer who campaigned for womens rights, the temperance, and was an abolitionist, helped form the National Woman Suffrage Association
