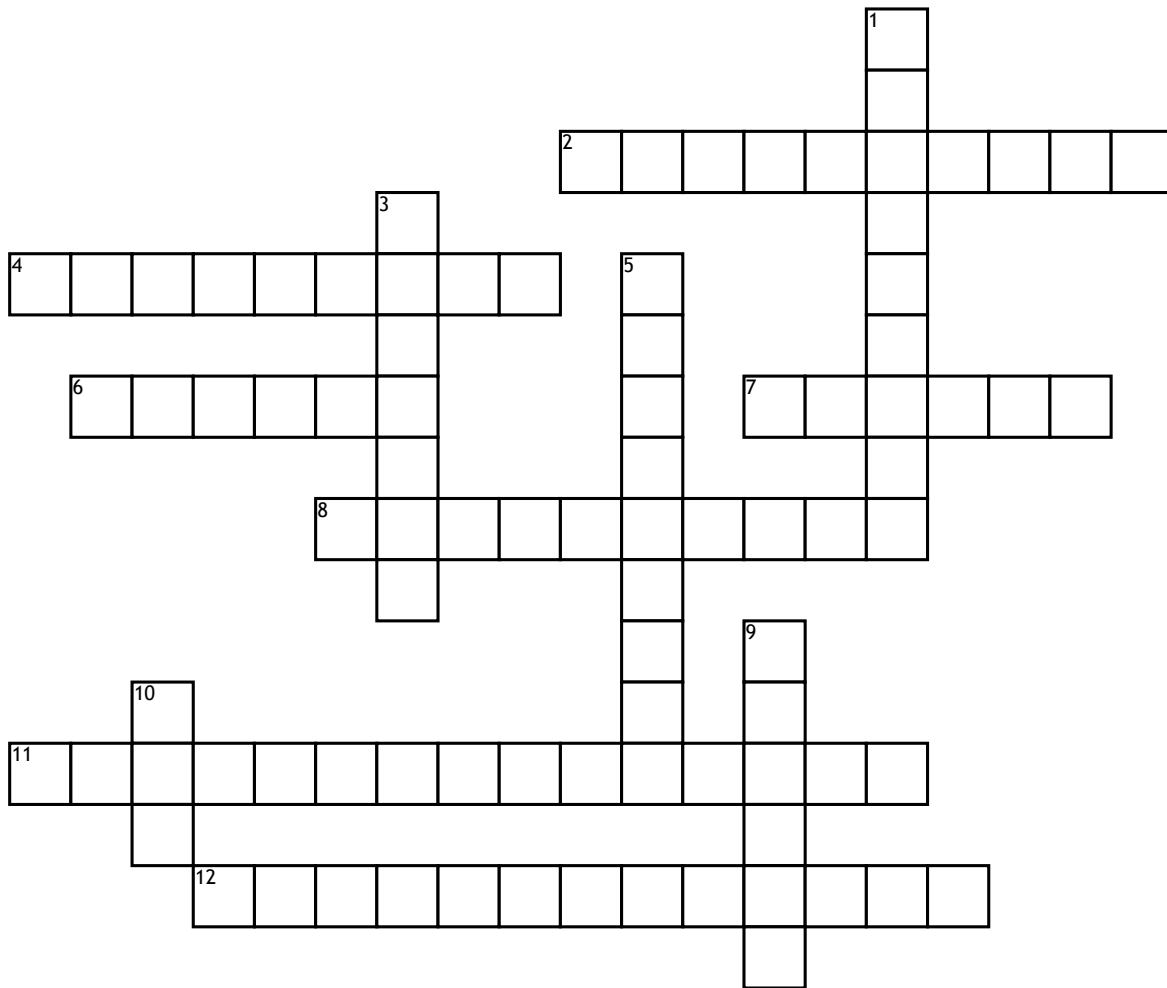


Immune System
