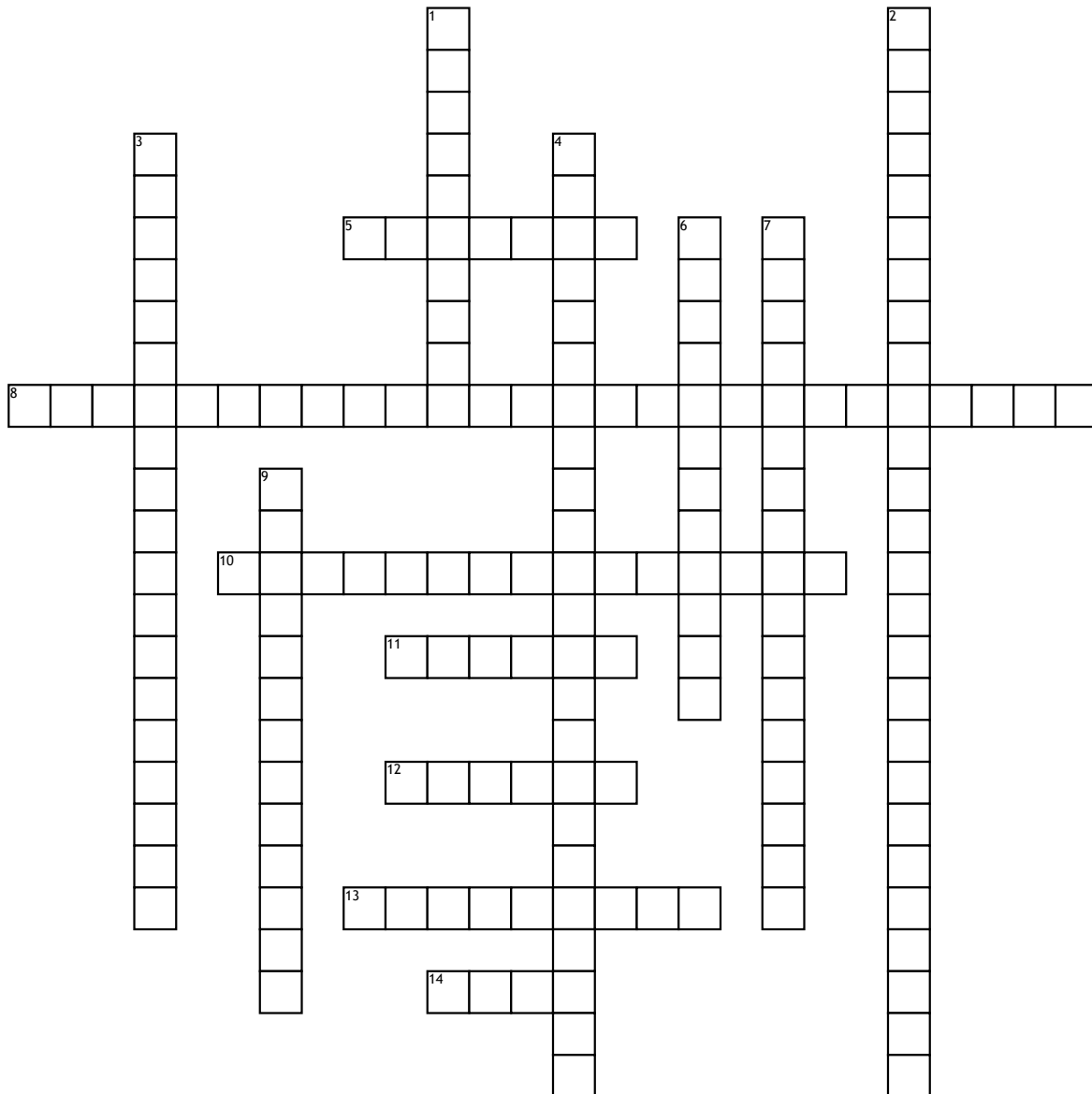

1. located in neck, armpit, and groin, small swellings in the lymphatic system where lymph is filtered and lymphocytes are formed

2. Compete with pathogens in gut and vagina

3. Exocrine- destroy bacteria

4. Cilia protect respiratory system

6. Protects the body against invading pathogens including bacteria, viruses, fungi, and protists

7. Gastric Acid destroys pathogens

9. Located in ileum of Sm. Intestine, protects GI tract from pathogens
