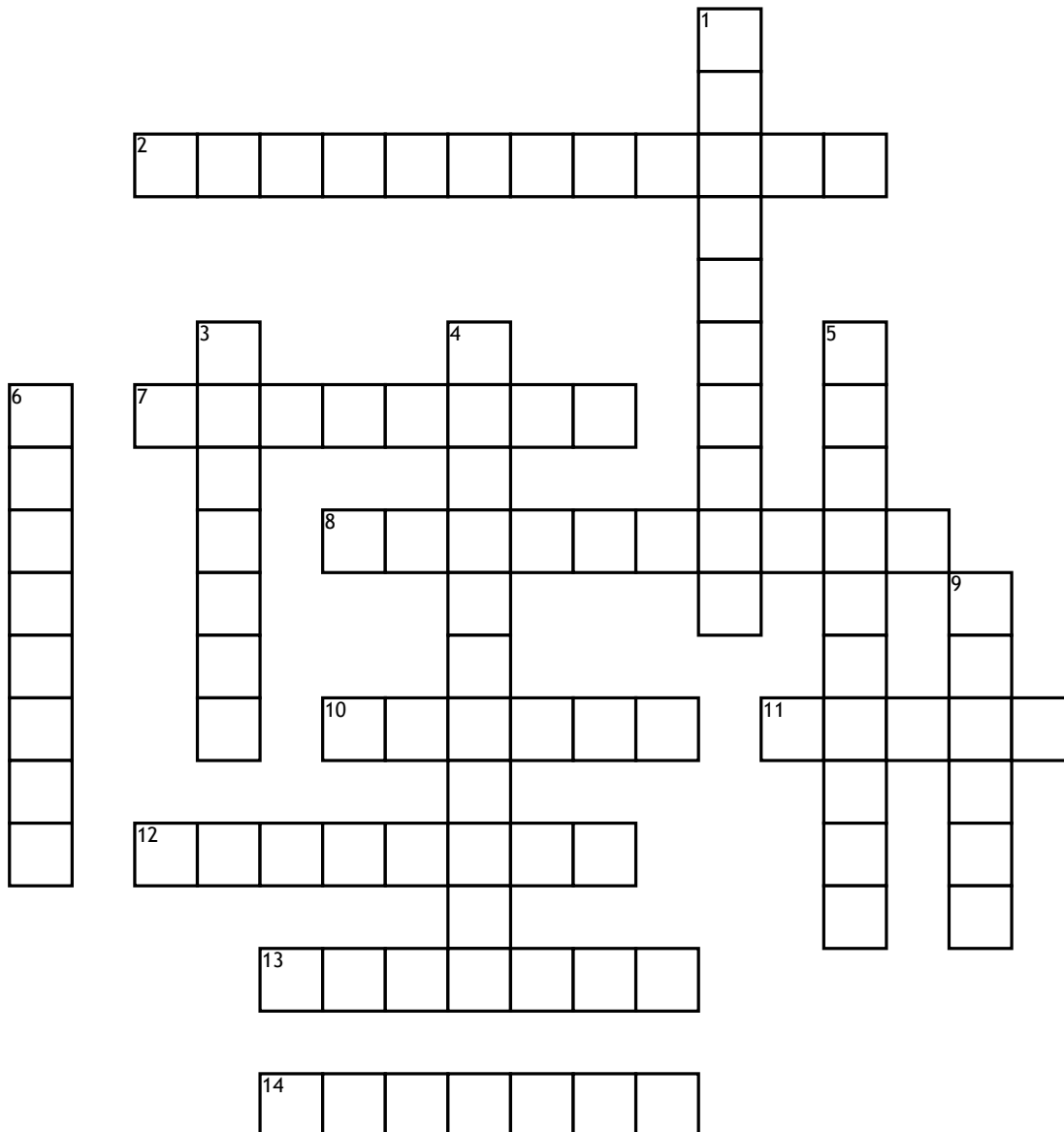


Immune System

2. Part of the body that helps fight against pathogens
 7. body proteins that bind to antigen and stop the pathogen from replicating, mark antigen for destruction
 8. are produced in an allergic response
 10. carries the disease but is not sick (aka mosquitos and malaria)

11. a non specific response to pathogens that increases body temperature

12. also known as acquired immunity, white blood cells
 13. acquired immunity, immunity from an outside source (not your body)
 14. overreaction to something not harmful, overactive immune system
