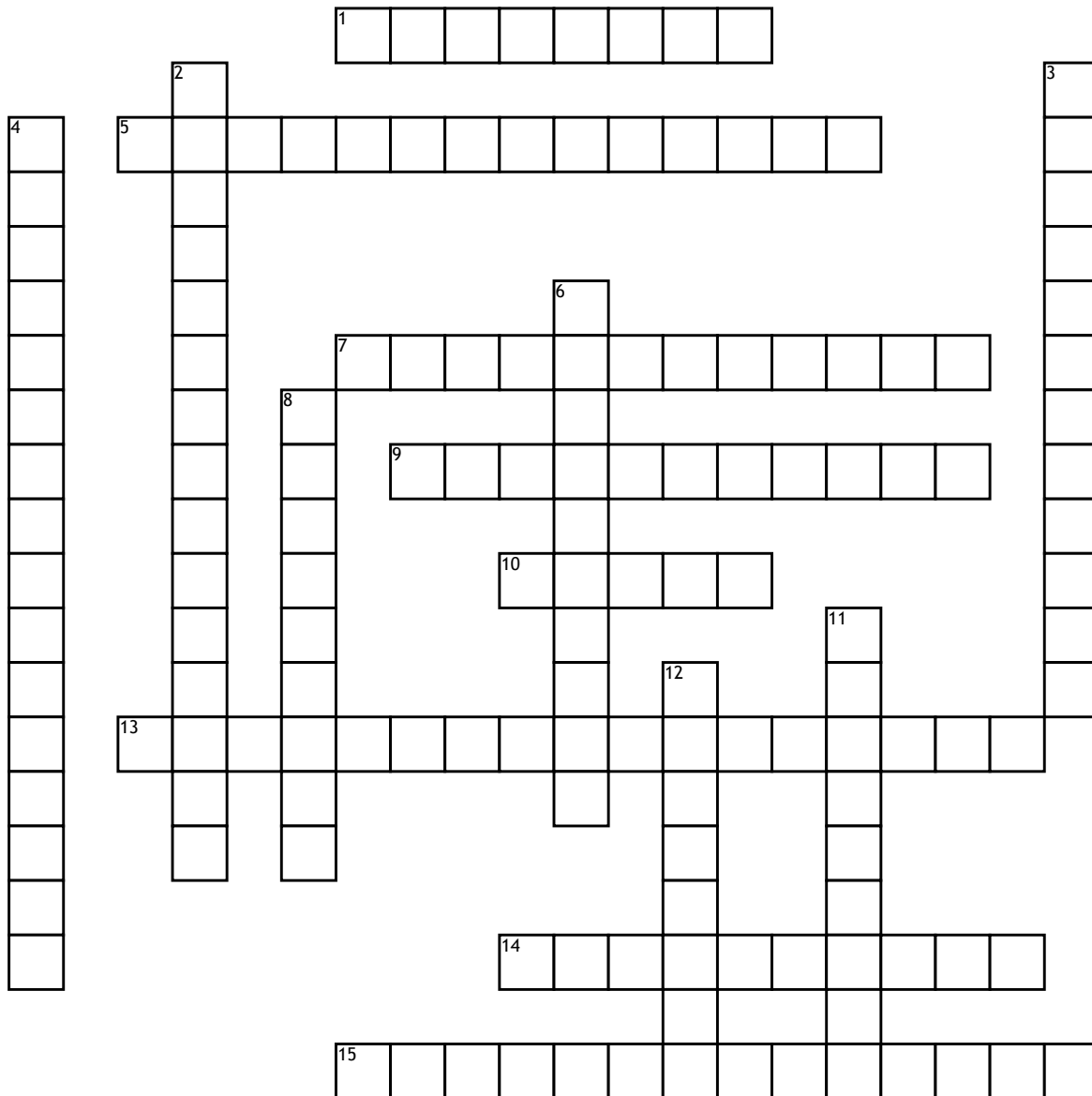


Imperialism Crossword
