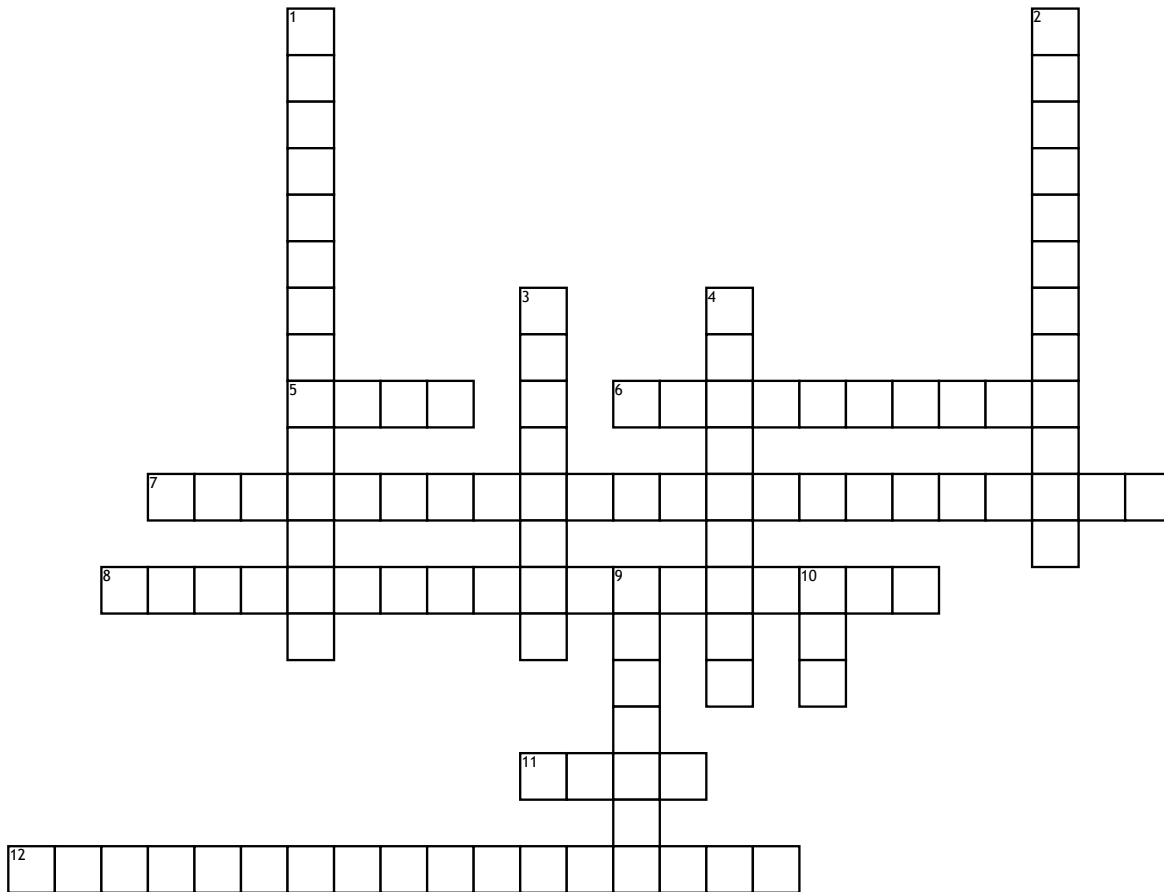


Inclusion of Children with Special Needs
