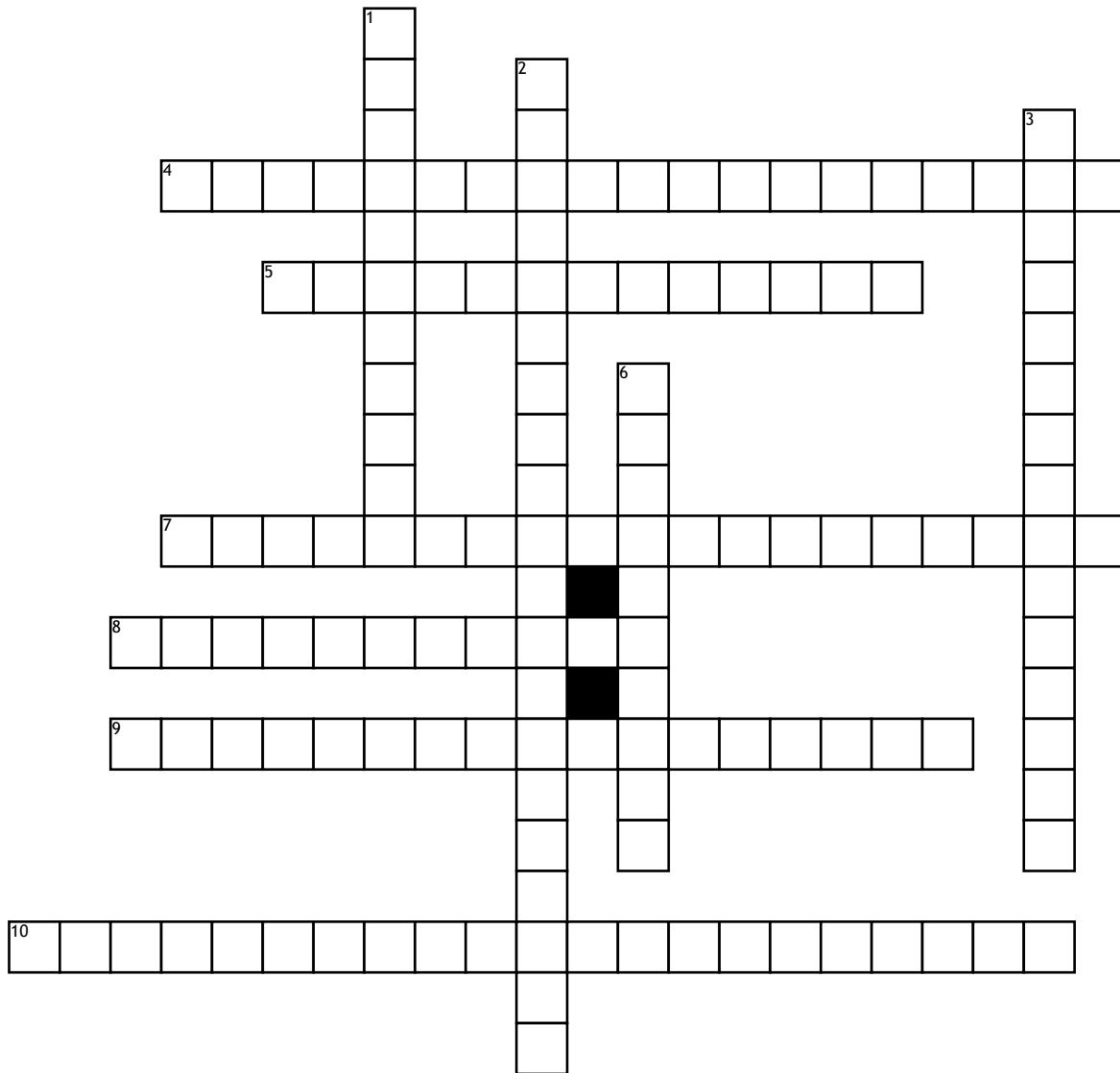


Industrial Age Crossword
