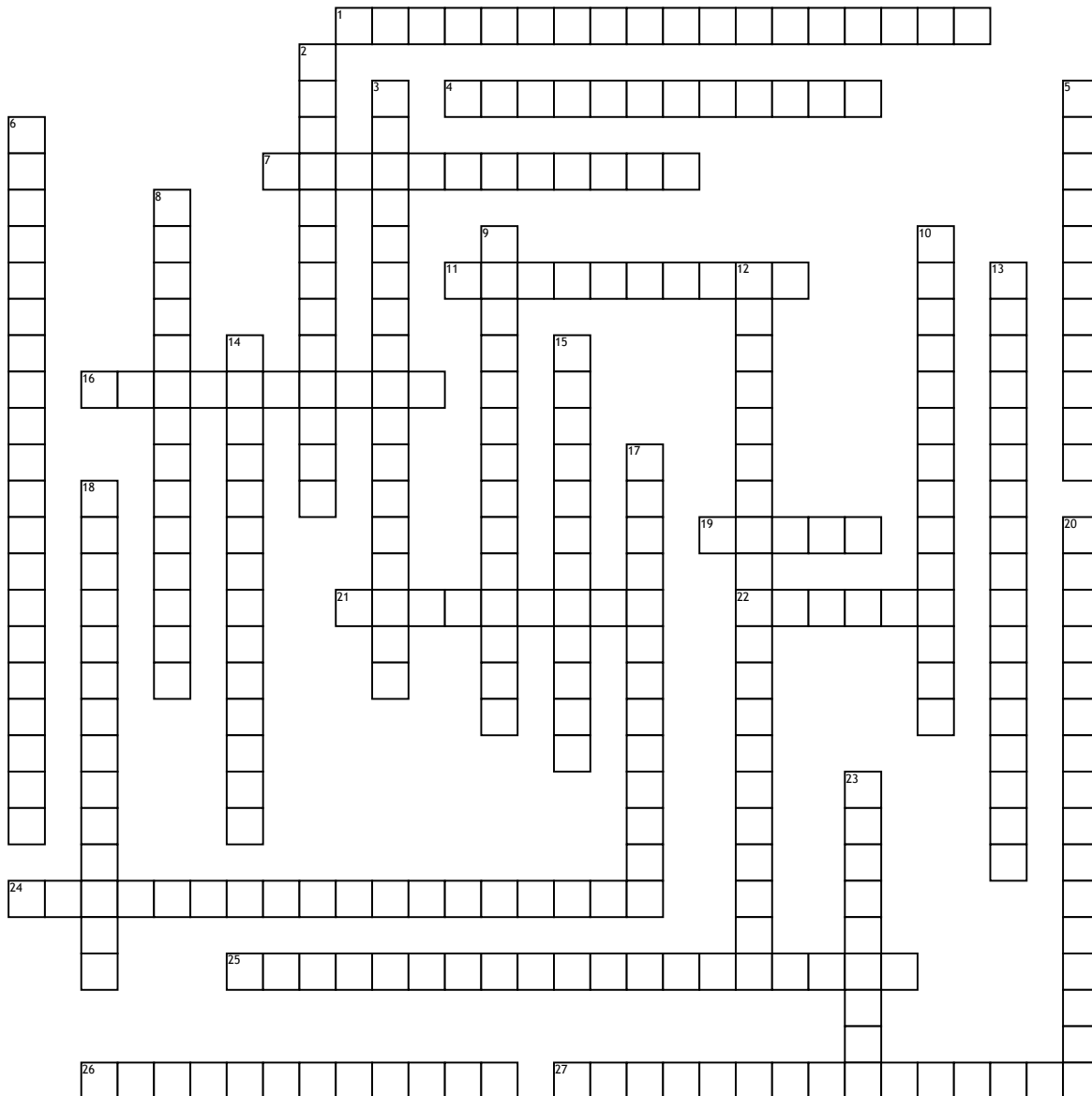


Industrial Revolution
