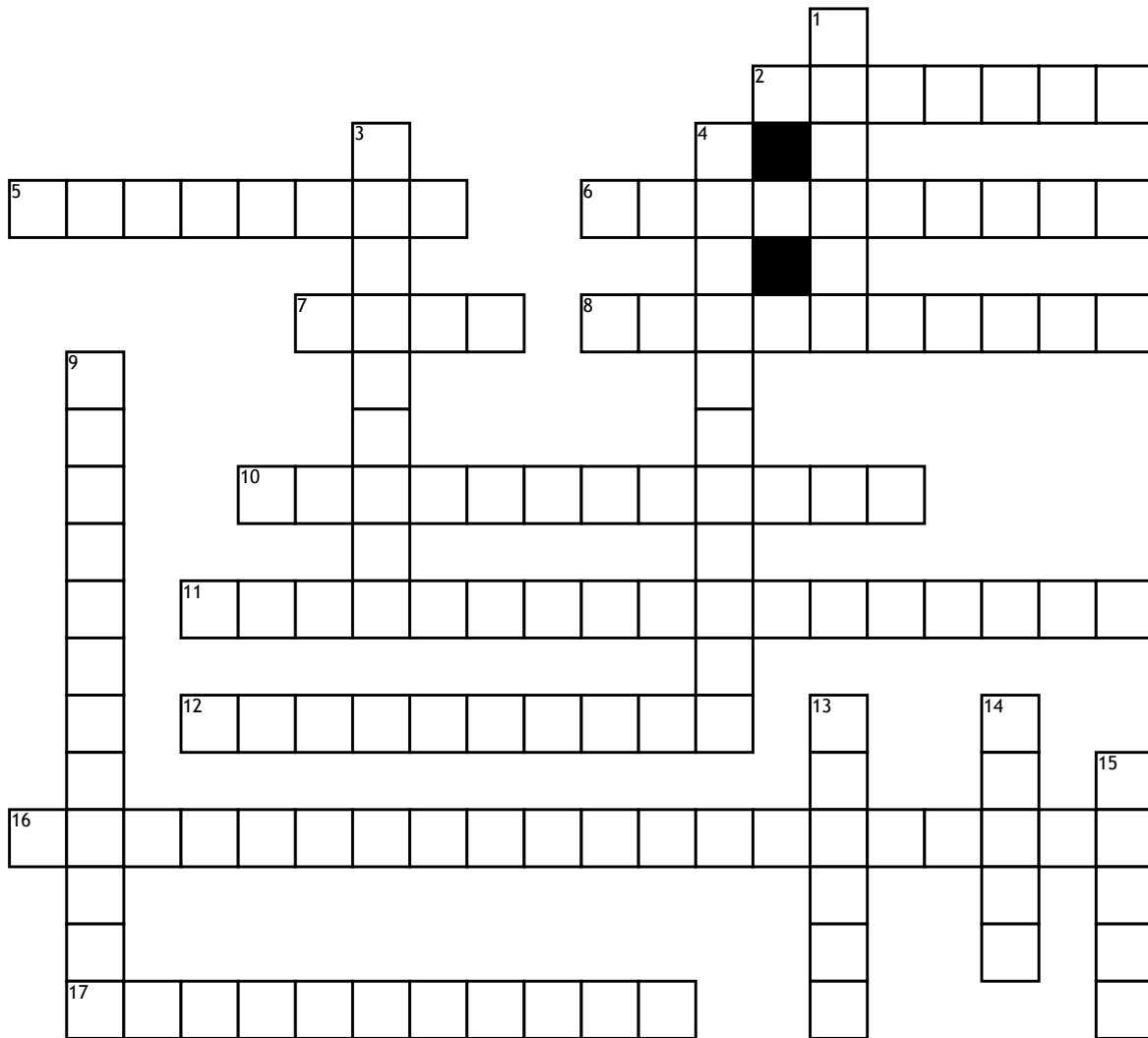


Industrial Revolution
