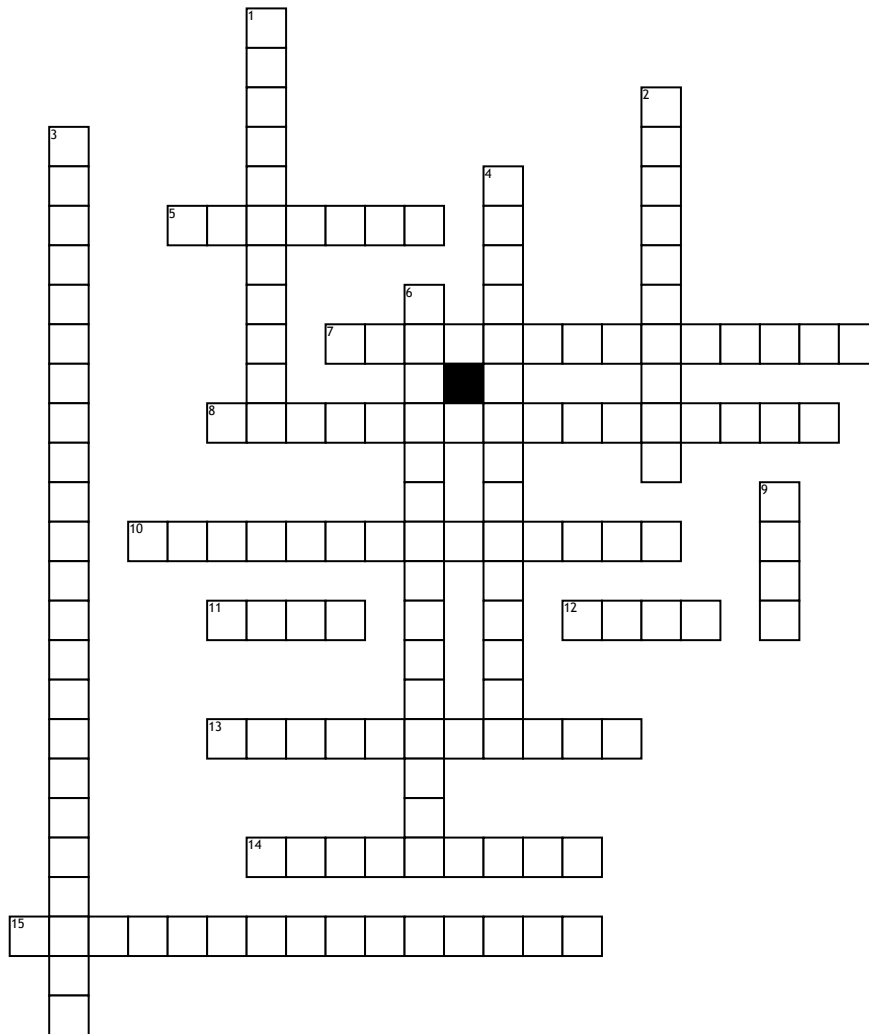


Industrial Revolution Crossword Puzzle
