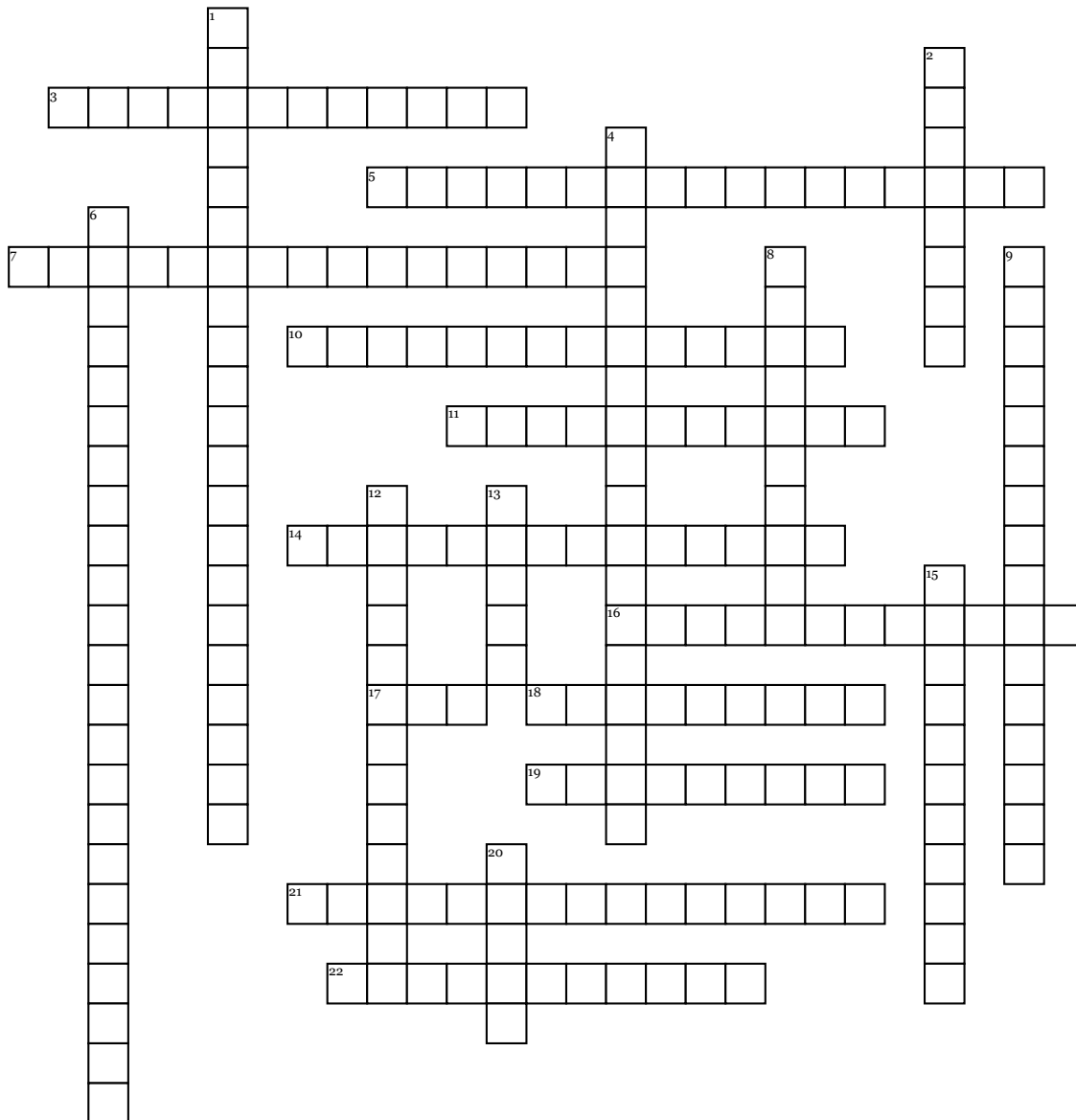


Industrial revolution crossword puzzle
