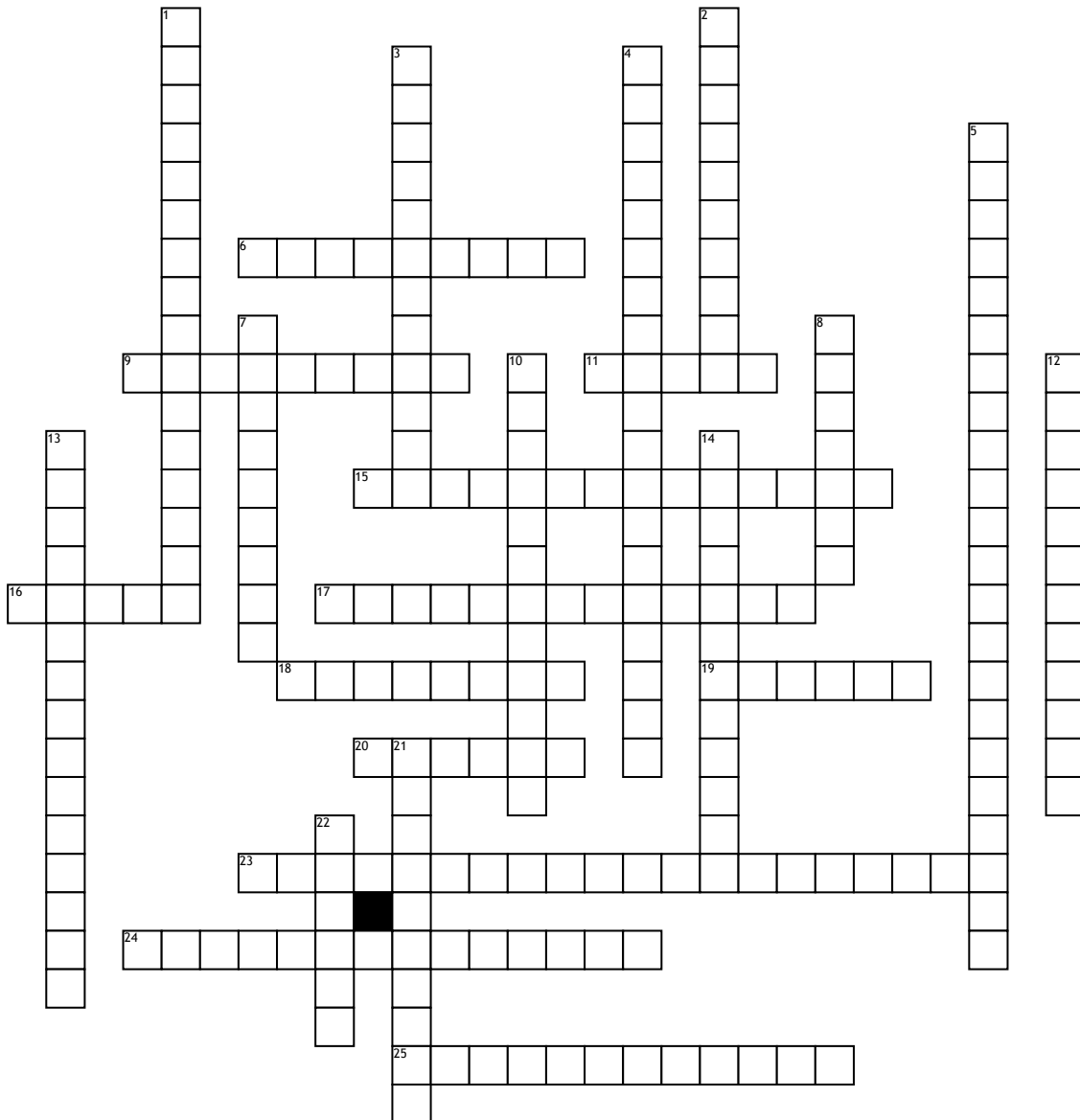


# Industry and Urban Growth Crossword Puzzle
