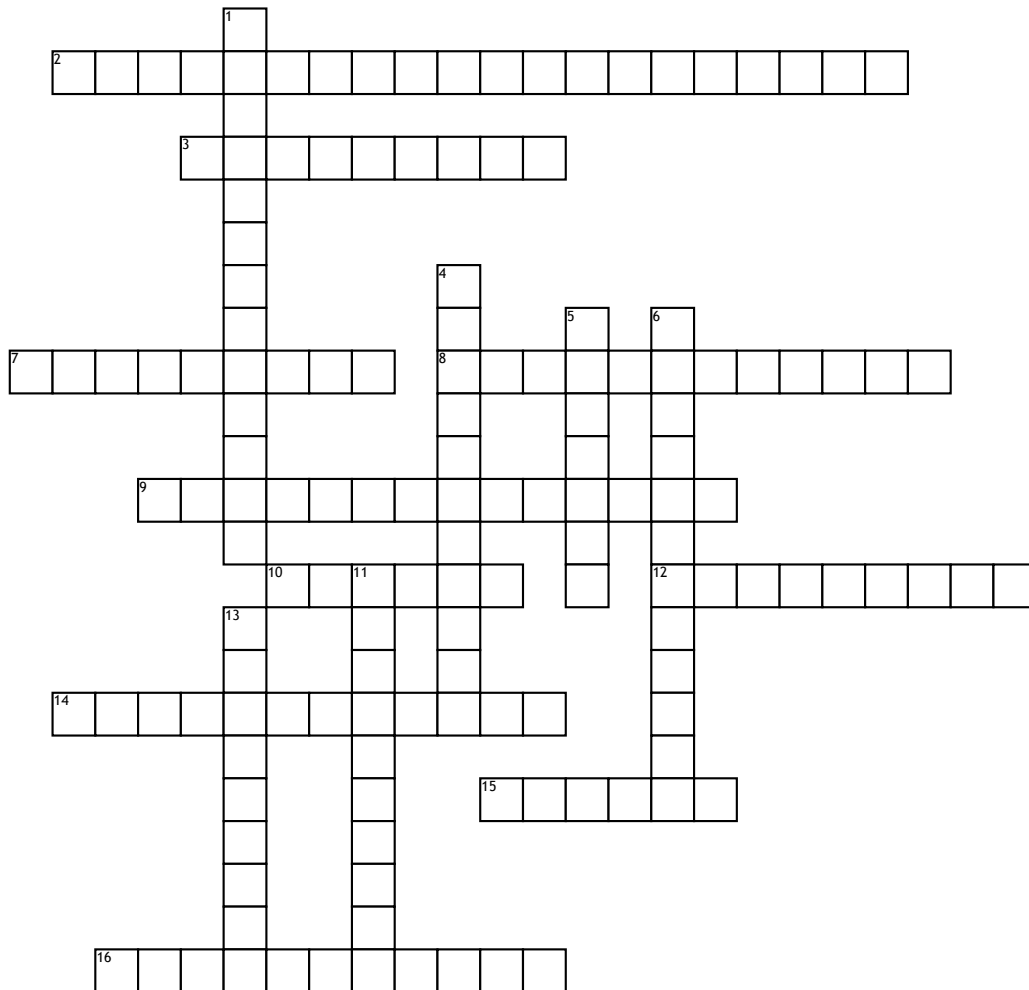

- 2. Spore forming bacterium that causes GI dysfunction and inflammation
- 3. Inflammation of the liver; blood-borne pathogen
- 7. A type of bacteria in the gut that serves to breakdown food
- 8. Normally found in the GI system, but some species can cause very resistant infections
- 9. Most common agent of infection
- 10. Microorganism is transmitted through an insect or animal

12. Seasonal respiratory infection

- 14. Inflammatory disease that primarily affects the lungs; lesions of the lungs causing exudation and necrosis
- 15. Opportunistic; lies dormant in dorsal root ganglia
- 16. Transmitted through ticks; causes flu-like symptoms

- 1. Secrete toxins that destroy cells and incite immune response

- 4. Secretes enzymes that allow it to invade and destroy cells, can be necrotizing

- 5. Microorganism is transmitted through a common source (food or water)
- 6. Another word for contagious
- 11. Inflammatory of dermis and hypodermis related to acute infection
- 13. Fatalities of disease compared overall number of cases of same disease
