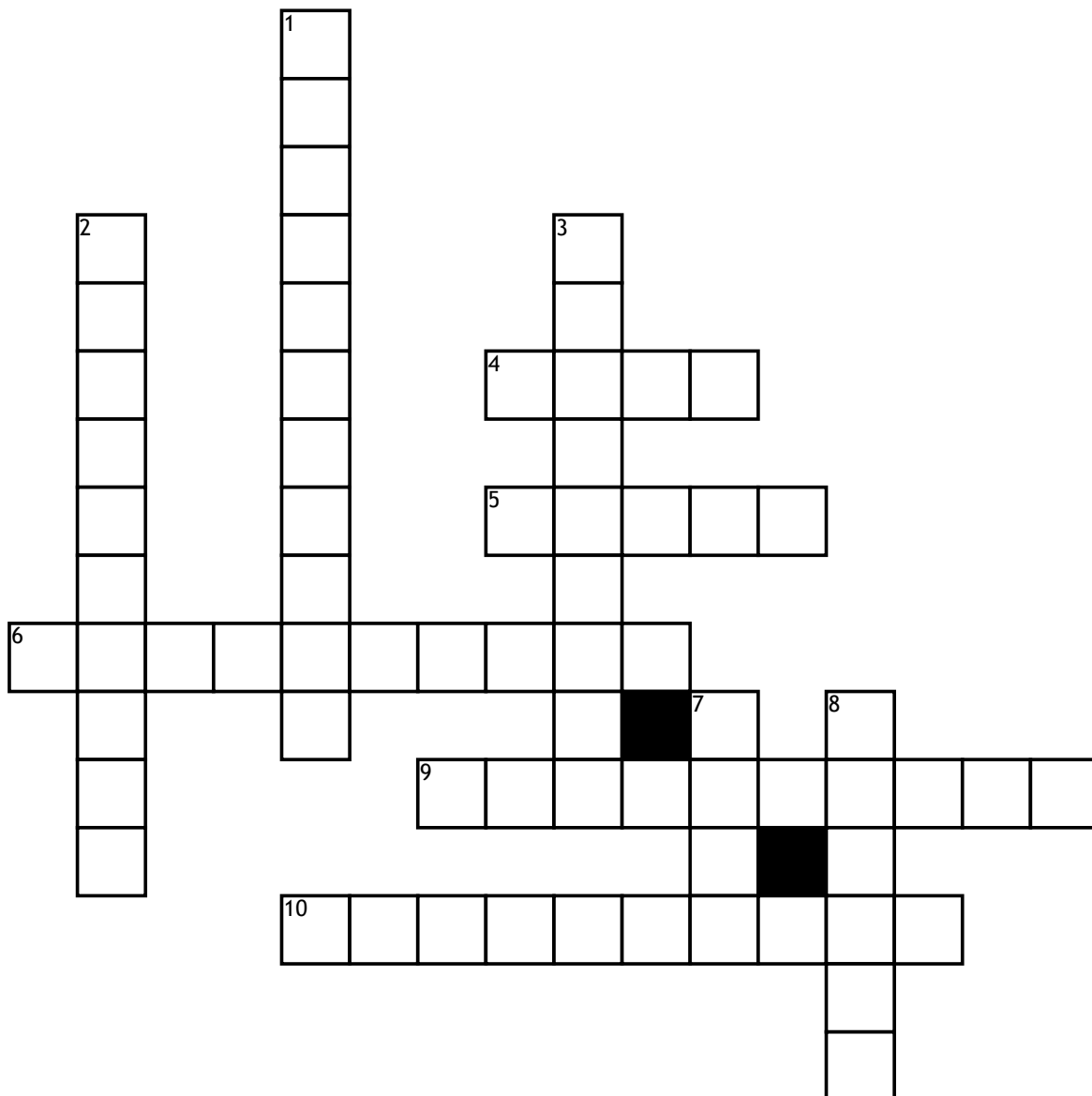


Inflammation and Wound Healing

4. Highly unpleasant sensation caused by illness or injury; The "P" in "PRISH"
5. An abnormal growth of cells that could be either benign or malignant
6. Impaired blood supply around a scar resulting in further tissue breakdown; Most common in the stomach
9. The passage of blood cells through the intact walls of the capillaries, typically accompanying inflammation
10. The passage of leukocytes through the endothelium and walls of capillaries during inflammation

Down

1. A condition of shortening and hardening of muscles, tendons, or other tissue, often leading to deformity and rigidity of joints
2. Unable to move; The "I" in "PRISH"
3. A lesion formed by mononuclear cells that surround a persistent irritant
7. Added or external energy that causes a rise in temperature, expansion, evaporation, or other physical change
8. Hypertrophic scar tissue
